

## History of the Ogle Family

It is said that the Ogle name originated in Northumberland, England where they held large tracts of land at the time of the Norman Conquest in the year 1066. They had two castles - Ogle Castle and Bothal Castle. The Ogle castle has all but disappeared while some of the Bothal ruins still remain. Both places are shown on the maps of Northumberland County, England.

The Ogles came to New Castle, Delaware long before the Revolutionary war and the village of Ogletown in that county occupies the site of the old homestead.

Many of the Ogle family were great lawyers, generals and other high ranking military men and mighty soldiers in time of war. Never did braver men go to the field of battle than the Ogles and never were there better lawyers in their day.

great Great - Great - Great - Great grandpa Joseph Ogle lived at Frederick County, Maryland on Arden Creek. He was a Captain in the army. His brother was General Alexander Ogle.

Captain Ogle later moved to Illinois where he died leaving five children, one of whom was Wm Ogle, my great great great<sup>great</sup> grandfather.

He married Katherine Young and they had 10 children, one of whom was my great - great grandpa Jesse Ogle. My great great great<sup>great</sup> grandpa Wm Ogle died. 1852.

great My great great<sup>great</sup> grandfather Jesse Ogle, married Rachel Burgess and they had five children, all lived around Kansas and Missouri except one son, who located in Coshocton. He was James<sup>B.</sup>, my great<sup>great</sup> grandpa James married Viola Smailes and they had 9 children, one of whom was James Thomas Ogle, my great grandfather. He married

1927 and my great grandpa Jim Ogle  
died about 1934, both in Isleta, O.

Both are buried in West Lafayette Cemetery.

Butter and they had three daughters,  
one of whom is my mother, Mildred King  
Grandpa Ogle passed away in 1967 and  
is buried beside his parents.
