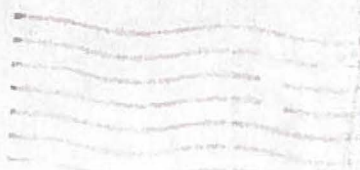

Dear Doris,

Thank you so much for the package! I eagerly opened it and found some really good matches for my Mansfields. Actually, my wife's Mansfields. I have enclosed a family group sheet for our Mansfields in case you did not get one previously. In answer to your P.S.- none of the Mansfields we know of came through Ohio. The ones who did leave Pennsylvania came to Chicago in the first part of this century. All, but one (wife's grandmother) went back to Armstrong County after some years.

I am in the process of sorting out what you sent. I truly believe that this family of William and Elizabeth Mansfield are the parents of the son, in which our Mansfields came from. The family group sheets you sent did not mention any Samuel, which is the connection. I would like to take you up on the offer of going through Margeret's file for more data. I don't know how inconvenient that would be, but I am so convinced that this is the family (due to the same Lutheran Church records of our Mansfields and Margeret's), that to disregard anything else in the file would be negligence.

You have of course gave me more than I expected, to which I am grateful. My problem has been finding Samuel's father, since I only have the mother (widow-Margeret Shuster). I originally thought that the father was going to be Christopher Mansfield, due to the IGI record saying a CHPR. Mansfield and Margeret Shuster had a son, Samuel born at Greensburg, Pa. in 1804. It is apparent that the Christopher on your sheets is not the one since he married a Sarah. This and the fact that Christopher and his family went to Ohio.

So my next effort would be to link my Samuel up with one of the other brothers, William Jr., Abraham, Jacob, John, David, or Solomon. The David Mansfield would be a good choice with his wife being a Margeret, but for the fact that there was no mention of a son Samuel and his birthdate-12/17/1796. Of course, the group sheet says he died in the 1830's and Samuel would have been married and on his own anyway, leaving the widow Margeret.

William Jr. would be the right age to be the father of Samuel, but a wife Catherine? James had no wife I take it? Abraham stayed in Westmoreland County, so thats a plus, but again no wife Margeret. John and brother Solomon again would be too young I

fear. So who could it be? Your help is once again pleaded for. If

in the future you could somehow obtain Margerets file, I would not know how to Thank you. I realize that much of this is mumbo jumbo to you since we are not related by these Mansfields in question. I can only say that by connecting them all, I can do a service to someone else and maybe even contribute someday to a bit of history of the residents of those counties which they came from.

Doris, I would like to include a small remittance to you for past and future postage. I know people like you do not expect monies and do such things by way of your kindness and love for genealogy. But I would appreciate you using it in case someone else makes inquiries later on. Well, I will close now and hope you and yours have a fine Thanksgiving and joyous Christmas season.

At the tenth annual reunion of the Mansfield Clan, held Saturday, August 19, 1922, at the Mansfield Grove, near Bethel Church, Armstrong County, Pa., a speech made by Harry O. Mansfield in which he advocated the collecting of the family history, met with much approval, and the President, James Mansfield, appointed the following committee to work on same: Chairperson Zola Mansfield Hoyt, Harry O. Mansfield, Mary Kahney Arnold and Charles Handrie.

The committee worked during that year collecting a record of the descendants of Samuel Mansfield. At the reunion in 1923 what they had accomplished was read, corrected, and approved and they were advised to continue the work.

In 1924 they reported their inability to go back farther than the said Samuel Mansfield and were advised to compile the history from there after first trying again through a professional genealogist for more information.

The committee wishes in this way to thank all those who so willingly cooperated with them in their work.

R Records given her were found in family Bibles or given by heads of families.

In the family Bible which was then in the possession of Findley Mansfield of Kelly Station, Pa. We find that Samuel Mansfield, the founder of the Mansfield family in Armstrong County, was born June 12, 1804 in Westmoreland County and died in August 13, 1880, and is buried in Bethel Cemetery near Kellys Station, Pa. He married on August 2, 1824, to Elizabeth Ashbaugh born March 8, 1801; died October 26, 1854. To this reunion were born seven children; six in Westmoreland County and one in Armstrong County.

In 1842 he came from Manor or Irvin, Westmoreland County, Pa., to a farm near Bethel Church, Armstrong County, bringing his wife and six children as follows:

- I. William, born April 22, 1826; died June 10, 1891.
- II. Sevilla, born Oct. 21, 1828; died Jan 17, 1866.
- III. Maryanne, born Sept 7, 1833; died Oct 30, 1855.
- IV. Josiah, born Nov 30, 1834; died July 25, 1904 (killed by a train)
- V. Lucy, born Dec 19, 1836; died Nov 17, 1909.
- VI. Samuel, born June 5, 1840; died June 4, 1926 (born Armstrong County)
- VII. Lewis, born April 10, 1842; died July 9, 1910.

(The following item was taken from the Deed Book No. 12, page 414, Armstrong County record of deeds.)

"On February 17, 1841, Samuel Mansfield of Hempfield Township, Westmoreland County, purchased a farm in what was then Allegheny Township, Armstrong County, from John Rhodes of Hemfield Township, for \$600. This farm is now located in Bethel Township, Allegheny Township, having been divided into several, one of which is Bethel."

On October 26, 1854, Elizabeth Ashbaugh Mansfield died. She is buried in Bethel Cemetery.

On January 22, 1856, Samuel Mansfield married Mary Highfield who was

born May 14, 1828; died May 12, 1909. The children of the second marriage were:

Samuel Mansfield was a farmer and a huckster. He belonged to the Lutheran Church. We know little about Samuel Mansfield's relations. According to his son Samuel he had two half-brothers, Michael and Henry Rowe, and a half-sister, Mrs. Anne Portzer, who lived on farms three miles east of Greensburg near Stony Springs, Westmoreland County. His mother's name was Margaret Shuster.

You did a lot of research! However, all those Shuttts you listed seem to be of another branch of a family tree. Cousins? Will we ever know?

Our Henry Shuttts was born Feb. 12, 1799 - probably in N. York. He married Martha Harvey Sept. 7, 1817. She was probably from New York.

Their children were Harvey Shuttts m. Eliza Wolford, John m. Lucinda Tease, Martha who married Dr. Alvin Chase in Muskingum Co., Ohio on April 29, 1841 - they are buried in Michigan. Lucinda b. 1824 m. Andrew Dyer April 19, 1843 in Muskingum Co., Ohio. These were my Gr. Grandparents. They are buried in Stark Co., Ohio. Henry m. Harriet Elliot, Jane m. Henry Hardy, Harrilla m. Samuel Elliot, Malintha, William m. Deborah Williams, Almervin m. Ann Shaw, Ann m. Joseph Roberts and the youngest named Mary Shuttts.

Because of the listing of the Harvey name in the Tuscarawas Pioneer Footprints we wrote to Margaret Wilson. We do appreciate your work on the Shuttts name. We have tried so many times to get data on the Shuttts / Harvey / Dyer link but usually to no avail. We know if we just hang in there long enough, we should make some connections. People like you spur us on. It seems that Margaret Wilson was researching both the Shuttts and the Harvey names. Am I correct? That would lead us to think there is a link somewhere!!

The Ancestor Chart which you sent (filled in by Mildred Houy 1982) had a Henry Shutt b. Dec. 6, 1814 died, Jan. 29 1900 - dates are close - perhaps a cousin?? You also endorsed a chart (done by Mianic Stingel Smith) which lists a Henry J. Shutt b. 1844 died 1912 - what a lot of Henry Shutt's !!!!

Please research the Harvey name only if it is connected to the Shutt's family or to Martha Harvey b. 1800. (no other dates on her available in our records)
