We are destined to see service before the autumn comes, but I think we can eat Thanksgiving at home. Rollin is still in the hospital and is getting better he will likely be back to camp by to-morrow. We are all anxious to be away and on the move.

The heat is intense but most all are standing it well. More boys from town will have a chance to come.
