EARLY HISTORY¹

Nicholas Rufenacht, born 6-14-1841 in Gertensea, near Steffisburg, near Lake Thun, Canton of Berne, Switzerland, had two brothers, John, Sam, and a sister Elizabeth. There is little known of his family except that they lived on a farm. His mother's family name was Shanie. Relatives of the brothers are believed to be living in Berne and Lucerne where there are many Rufenacht listings in the telephone directories. Virginia Leiendecker visited Emma Rufenacht-Probst in Berne in 1963. Emma was John's granddaughter, thus a grandniece of Nicholas.

During her visit Emma, her son, Peter, and his wife Erika, and their two sons journeyed from Berne in two cars to see where the Rufenacht brothers and sister were born and spent their first fifteen to twenty years. No descendants seem to be living there now. They visited the mountain village of Gertensea, the place of Nicholas' birth, and Virginia has pictures she took of houses in the village, the new church and the old graveyard where gravestones date to before 1800, none bearing the name Rufenacht.

They also visited Thalgut on the Aare River, where Mary Ann's family operated a pension, 1840 to early 1900's. It is in operations today as Gasthaus Thalgut Pension. The present management has no knowledge of the Strean period of operation. It is a newer larger building than shown in pictures sent to the United States in 1903, which Virginia has in her memorabilia. Her picture shows the pension as having three stories, a first floor porch, second and third story balconies and could have quite a few guest rooms. A large two story house is back of the larger structure, but apparently on the same property as they appear to almost touch. The picture shows the bridge with two stone supporting structures in the water so the river must be fairly wide at this spot. Cement or stone walls are along the banks to prevent erosion and flooding.

Hilda Stocker visited the same spot in 1980. At that time there was still a pension with a dining area along the Aare with red and white table and chairs. The bridge had been moved west and is a part of a new highway through the valley. The pension was like a little settlement of four or five buildings. The pension

building was the largest, but the others also were substantial buildings, nicely located by the side of a local road, narrower than the larger highway through the valley. The current of the river is swift. Canoes floated by without help from the paddler. Within a half hour several canoes floated by. It is a lovely location.

The settlement of Thalgut, Canton of Berne, is on the Aare River, which runs southeast into Lake Thun. The river's source is northwest of Berne, passing through Berne before reaching Thalgut near Steffisburg. The river valley at Thalgut is a mile or more wide containing good farm land. The hills rise gently toward the mountains.

When Nicholas was approximately twenty years, he married Mary Ann Strean, who was one year younger and whose mother's family name was Smythe. Their villages were not far apart. They continued to live in the same general neighborhood until circa 1868 when they came to the United States with four small children, Fred, Mary, Rose and Elizabeth. Fred was six years old and Elizabeth an infant in arms.

They came directly to Ohio settling in Glasgow in Tuscarawas County, Ohio. It is not known to us why he settled there or if he had previous contact with anyone in the United States. This was a period in the history of Glasgow when it was thought Glasgow had the possibility of becoming an iron smelting center since coal was easily available and it was also thought there were sufficient deposits of iron ore to support such an industry. It was operated by a Scottish firm. The deposits of ore were not rich so the operation never grew, in fact later closed completely.

Nicholas and his family lived in a house in Glasgow, a small settlement near the mines and plant, and worked at the plant. We know Fred worked in the mines.

Nicholas bought some acreage for farming nearby on which was a good spring. He promptly built a log house near the spring, later a large barn, planted grape vines, and a fruit orchard. Fences were built and he acquired horses and cows as he was financially able to do so. In later years he had a good sized herd of cows.

Mary Ann's mother, Elizabeth Smythe Strean, who was a milliner by trade, came from Switzerland to live with her daughter. She made hats and took them seasonally to Nargny's on the Square in Port Washington for sale. Some were shipped to Denison. She later married a second time to a Swiss man named Neiderhouser but when and where is unknown to us. However, we do know her son John by that marriage who was Mary Ann's half-brother was in later years a merchant in Canton, where she spent her later years. She is buried in Canton. John Neiderhouser had several children. Mary, Donald, Harold and Wendell were remembered. There may have been others. The names of Margaret Bertha, Alice Mary appear in old correspondence. One was a missionary in China.

It is through Elizabeth Smythe, Strean, Neiderhouser that the relationship to the Spring family is traced. The names of Offelter and Beebe are connected with families of the second marriage. The only memories that have been repeated often enough by older members of the family to remember are she worked in her room where she had lace, feathers, ribbons and flowers, smoked a pipe, and read the Bible daily. Some grandchildren remember taking her meal to her room. They were not permitted to touch anything.

Later Nicholas built a frame house in which his son John and his wife Daisy (Frame) lived until he bought the farm east of Newcomerstown and moved there. It was then that Nicholas and Mary Ann moved from the log house into it, living there for the remainder of their time on the farm.

The present Interstate Route 77 goes through the spot where the houses and barn stood, just north and a little east of the turnoff for U.S Route 36 to Newcomerstown, Port Washington, and Gnadenhutten. A white frame house stands on the west side of Route 77 which around 1910-20 was known as the Decker house and directly across from the Rufenacht home. It was opposite this house that a short lane led east into the Rufenacht farm. The Rufenacht houses and barn were located approximately where the road has been built.

The family was affiliated with the German Evangelical Church in Port Washington, where their children were baptized and confirmed. Nicholas spoke German, Swiss, French and English. Some of the services were in German at that time and the family attended regularly in a surrey "with the fringe on top".

Some grandchildren remember him playing an accordion, singing folk tunes, and yodeling.

Mary Ann's death occurred 4-6-1908. She is buried in Union Cemetery, Port Washington. Nicholas after selling the farm spent his later years with his daughters Rosa and Caroline in Dover, Ohio. His death came 4-18-1929 and his burial was beside Mary Ann in the Port Washington cemetery. The spot is marked by a tombstone which carries the following:

A liberal interpretation is "She blessed us. She was a wonderful mother."

At the time of his death, 24 young people called him Grandfather and 15 Great-Grandfather. At this writing there are 144 direct living descendants.
