He was born June 22, 1925, at West Lafayette, a son of the late Joseph A. and Mary Ross Addy. He was co-owner and operator of Paul Addy Motors in New Philadelphia. He was formerly employed for 13 years at Ohio Power and for eight years at Humphries Auto City in Dover. He was a Navy veteran, having served during both World War II and the Korean War. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge in Newcomerstown.

Tragic accident reviewed in pages

Helen Addy of New Philadelphia, a former resident of Newcomerstown, submitted the following article on the tragic deaths of two local men, William Ross and Charles Smith. The fiery accident occurred at the old Clow Works in Newcomerstown in the early 1900's.

The article originally was published in the July 5, 1905 issue of *The Index*, now *The Newcomerstown News*.

Mrs. Addy's late husband, Paul Addy, who was raised in Newcomerstown, was a grandson of one of the victims, William Ross. Mrs. Clyde (Marjorie) Carruthers of Newcomerstown also is a grandchild of Mr. Ross.

Ross had two children, the late Mrs. Joe (Mary) Addy, who is buried at West Lawn Cemetery, and the late Frank Ross, buried at Bethel Cemetery, north of Newcomerstown. Mary was three-months-old at the time of the accident, and Frank was 12. The widow of Ross was the late Nettie Best.

The main headline of the article read, **BOTH VICTIMS ARE DEAD**, under which three sub-headlines read —

"Poor Billy Ross Goes First. Dies at Midnight On Thursday After Twelve Hours of Intense Suffering."

"Charley Smith's Spirit Leaves The Fire-Scarred Body Just After Twelve O'clock On Friday Night," and "Full Account of a Tragedy Which Has Deeply Stirred The People."

The article as it was printed follows.

"In response to a general demand for the details of the tragedy in which two of Newcomerstown's worthy citizens lost their lives last week, *The Index* prints the following:

Wednesday last at about 11:30 a.m. under the direction of Geo. P. Ortt, the cupola boss, about 3,000 pounds of metal had been drawn from the cupola into the great ladle, and Craneman Seymour Gardner had delivered this seething mass to different flasks along the pit.

Two thousand pounds or more had been poured, and the remainder, more than half a ton had been started back to the cupola. In some way the ladle containing this surplus metal came in contact with one of the big iron flasks and the gearing of the former was broken. By this mishap control of the ladle was lost, and the slightest push would cause this evenly-balanced receptacle to tilt, and thus spill its contents.

Men who witnessed the breaking of the gearing, and noticed that the

craneman was still hoisting the ladle rather than lowering it to the ground and realizing what might happen, began to break for cover, and Tony Gardner, it is said, rushed ahead of the disabled ladle shouting to the workmen to get out of the way.

Mr. Ortt, the cupola manager, and Messrs. William Ross and Charles Smith were in the little depression through which the track extends and on which the truck that bears the ladle runs. As Mr. Gardner shouted, Mr. Ortt sprang out of the depression and shot under the cupola, Mr. Ross following. At the same moment Mr. Smith ran east along a track which leads toward the test house.

In that dreadful moment the ladle tilted, hurling its seething, writhing, boiling, red-hot contents to the earth. Instantly the air was a mass of the burning liquid rebounding with explosive force the instant it struck the moist ground.

Mr. Ortt had cleared the little depression, had shot under the cupola, and save for minor burns on his feet, was safe. Not so, Mr. Ross who had attempted to follow him, and Mr. Smith who had fled in the opposite direction.

Mr. Ross in attempting to spring out of the depression, had evidently struck his knee with great violence on the low wall which bounds the depression and was thrown forward, the great liquid, burning mass striking and enveloping him at the same moment.

A piercing cry of agony, and the burning man sprang from the sea of liquid fire, his clothes burned from his body, his hands, arms, face, and limbs cooking in the awful heat. Heartsick men rushed for cotton and lindseed oil, supplies of which are always kept at the shops, and the poor, fire-racked, quivering flesh was enveloped in the oil and cotton.

Mr. Smith who had tried to escape in an opposite direction was also too late. The hissing mass enveloped him as it had his companions, and his clothes were burned from his body. Even the bottom of his shoes, as well as those of Mr. Ross were filled with liquid iron. Willing hands sur-

rounded him too, and in a minute the poor burned body was being enswathed in oil and cotton.

Dr. R.A. Goudy arrived quickly, but under the awful conditions little could be done. No hope could be held out that the life of either of the victims would be spared. Hoping against hope, physician, officers of the works and employes did everything which human ingenuity could devise. The doomed men were tenderly borne to their homes, and then the vigil began.

It was in vain, twelve hours later, the spirit of William Ross had taken its flight. For twenty-four hours more, Charley Smith suffered on, conscious too for the most part of his

hopeless condition, and then death came — came mercifully — to relieve him of the agony he endured.

THE FUNERALS

Newcomerstown has probably never witnessed a more memorable funeral. As a mark of sympathy every department of the Clow Works was closed for Mr. Ross's funeral on Saturday, and the workmen in solemn procession marched two and two, three hundred strong, behind the hearse of their late comrade in toil. It was a touching sight. The head of the procession arriving at the M.E. church, these fellow workmen in open ranks with lowered heads, their hats on their breasts, permitted the coffin bearing their dead comrade and the mourning family to pass in to the church, closely followed by the Pathfinders of whom the deceased was an honor member.

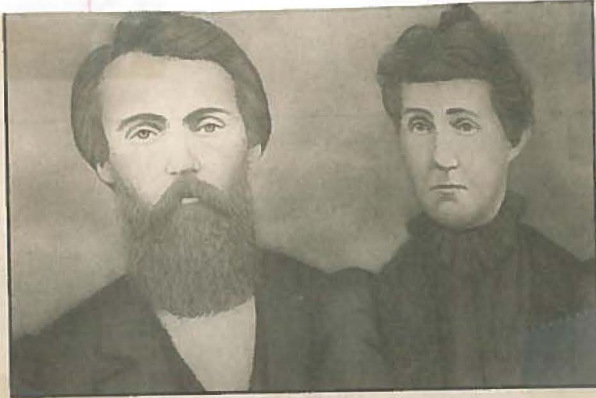
By this time the church, gallery and aisles, was crowded and Clow workmen gathered in groups near the church, many not able to get sufficiently close to hear the preacher's fervent words.

Beautiful and costly floral pieces, the gift of the Clow employes, and of the Pathfinders were borne in the procession, and rested on the coffin while Rev. H.B. Ernsberger delivered the funeral sermon.

On Sunday morning at Mr. Smith's funeral, the same impressive scenes were enacted. At 8 o'clock the Clow employes gathered at the Works and marched to the late home of the deceased on south River street.

Later the hearse started for St. Jacob's church on the hill south of town where the sermon was to be preached and interment was had. The workmen bearing beautiful floral pieces marched as on the day previous in double column until the river bridge was reached, and from this point those not provided with carriages returned.

As before, Rev. H.B. Ernsberger preached the discourse. It so happened that both victims of the tragedy were members of Mr. Ernsberger's churches, the first named, of St. Paul's in this city, and the other of St. Jacob's south of town."

Nc'town Historical Society searching for Addy descendants

The Newcomerstown Historical Society recently received a charcoal portrait and a request to find a descendant or descendants of the family in order to place it with the nearest relatives. The writing on the back of the picture is "John and Mary Ann Addy. John was a twin to James born 10-31-1840." After doing some research on the family, further information has come to light.

John Addy was born Oct. 31, 1840, in Adams Township, Coshocton County, and died 1881 in Adams Township, Coshocton County. He married Mary Ann Mackey on June 25, 1864. She was born 18 May, 1845, in Ohio and died April 4, 1926, in Newcomerstown, Tuscarawas County. John was the third grandson of William Addy, who was born 1750 in Ulster, Ireland, and died 1827 in Guernsey County. William married Elanor Clark on Dec. 22, 1768, in Wilmington, New Castle, Del. Elanor was born 1753 in Mill Creek, North Castle, Del., and died 1820 in Guernsey County.

John and Mary Ann Addy had four daughters and

one son. These children are as follows: Lydia, born July 14, 1873, in Adams Township, Coshocton County, and died April 1, 1940, in Newcomerstown, Tuscarawas County; second child, Nannie (Minnie), born Feb. 8, 1872, and died Sept. 11, 1872; the only son died in infancy, John Jr, born July 12, 1865, in Coshocton County Ohio, died March 15, 1866, in Coshocton County; Martha A. Addy was born Feb. 10, 1867, in Oxford Township, Coshocton County, and died Dec. 18, 1944, in Newcomerstown, Tuscarawas County; and the youngest daughter, Alta Carrie, was born Sept. 29, 1869, and died in infancy in Coshocton County.

The records of marriages show that daughters, Lydia married George Swigert, Martha married John W. Gardner and Alta Carrie married Benson Fiestery.

If you can document your decedancy to John and Mary Ann, the Newcomerstown Historical Society would like to hear from you.

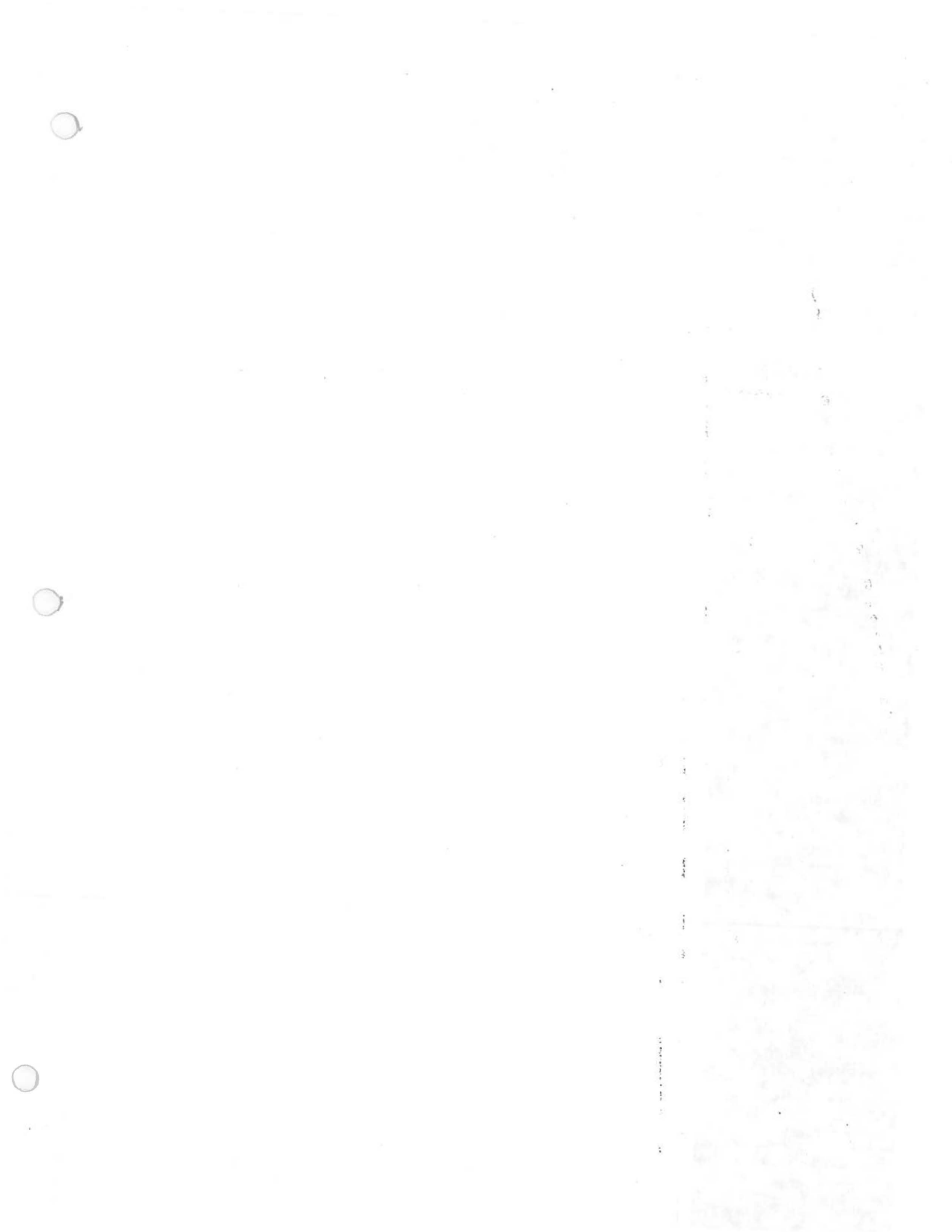

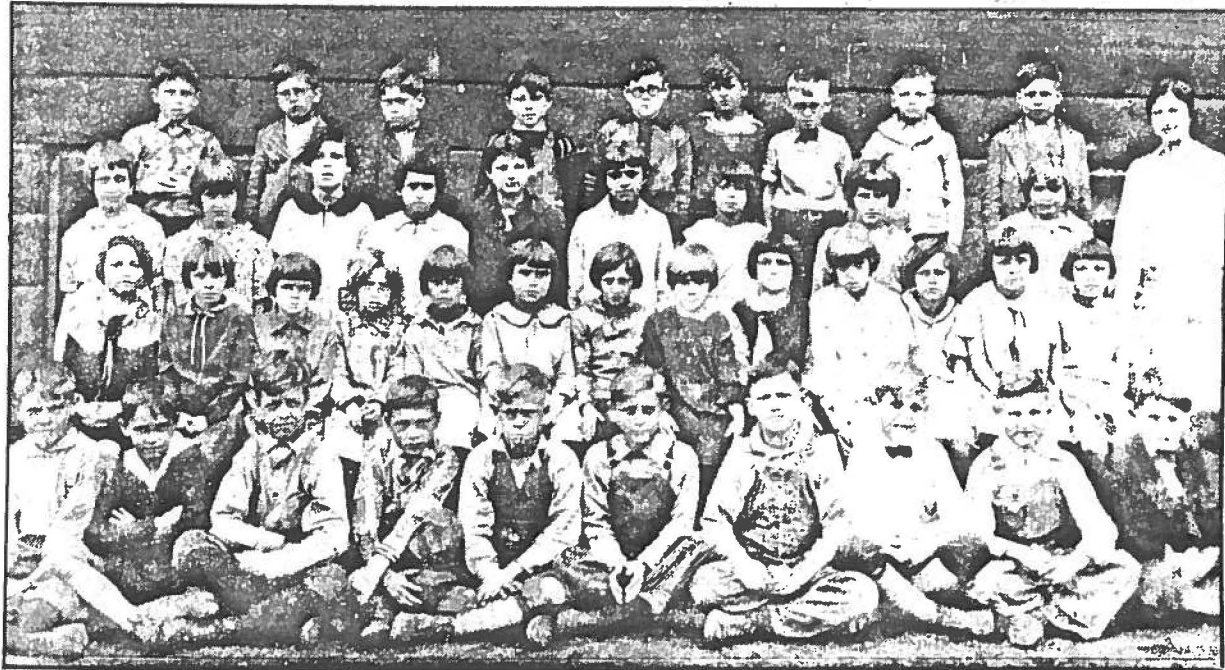

Interview No. XLVIII

I have not a very long yarn to tell. I was 79 years on
the third day of last May, consequently I was born in
1796. Old Virginia is my native State. I was born
in Jefferson County, within three miles of Harper's
Spring, on the Shepardstown Road, and lived there
until I was twelve years old, when my father came
to Ohio, and settled in Coshocton County, on Wills
Creek near the village now known as Jacob Port.

My father's given name was William. He was a
native of Ireland. Mother's maiden name was
Ellen Clark. I know nothing of my progenitors beyond
my own parents

I am the youngest of fifteen children, Only
two of us are alive. My sister Mary married
Reason (Rezin) Baker. They reside in Coshocton
County.

I well remember the journey from Virginia
to Coshocton County. We came in a wagon to which
fine teams were attached, we brought out seven
horses and several cows. Two of my sisters, Martha
and Nancy were already married and they remained
behind, but afterwards came. Brother Robert was
also married and had also come out to Tuscarawas
County, and we settled near him. Some of the
children had died in Virginia

Nine came out at once, Father, Mother, sisters
Mary and

and Joanna, and William, Hugh, John, Thomas and myself (James) as it was in 1868 when we journeyed, we do not meet with any great difficulty in getting along. One incident impressed me deeply. When we were on the top of the Allegheny mountains we came across two parties who had met, strange to us, but evidently relatives or old acquaintances. They were crying bitterly. They were on pack horses. It seems that one family had started for the West and the other was returning from the west to Virginia. I suppose the returning party gave a most lugubrious account of affairs in the west, and with such effect as to cause the emigrating party to turn back.

When we arrived in Tuscarawas County we remained with brother Robert. There was no other whites within six miles of us, but plenty of Indians. Father and the boys proceeded to make a small clearing, erect a Cabin and we moved in, when clearing out the forest for a farm was at once commenced. We arrived in the fall. That fall we sowed some wheat and the next spring planted corn.

The corn was healthy and good, but the wheat was sickly, and though it apparently made good flour and light nice bread, it made us sick to eat it. A part of the grain had a red end, and it was those which contained the poison. Even the cattle and hogs were made sick eating it.

But the crop of wheat grown on the same land the second year was good.

When about fifteen years of age, I imagined I was not so well treated as I ought to be, but for so thinking, I have since become fully persuaded I was a very foolish youngster and thought I was neglected because they were getting what befitted their age, and which I was substantially allowed in due course of time. So I like many other foolish and undutiful sons, resolved to run away.

So I "lit out" between two days and clandestinely left kind parents and loving brothers and sisters to be pained at my conduct and apprehensive for my comfort and safety. I went to Dillon's furnace, Jamesville, and hired as a Chopper. In the course of three or four months my brother Hugh, William and John came down Will's Creek and the Muskingum river with a raft of timber and learning of my whereabouts came to see me and persuaded me to return home, where I remained awhile, until another runaway fit seized me, and I went again, this time "taking away a nephew, my sister's child. We were overtaken when some miles away by my Companion's father, Knock Jones (E. man) who took his son back with him and said to me that my brother would soon overtake and carry me back. We had agreed to go to Virginia, but on being left alone I changed my course and went to Cambridge and from there struck out to Jamesville again.

On reaching that place I found a man going down the Muskingum and Ohio Rivers to Cincinnati with a load of produce, who hired me as a hand. Proceeding to that city, where I hired out to work for ten dollars a month. This was in 1812. After awhile I became acquainted with James Guthrie, an Army Contractor. He offered me \$20 a month to team with him. I engaged and he sent me up to St. Mary's, Alleghany County, with a four horse team, loaded with Army supplies. I was gone more than two weeks, and owing to the desperate conditions of the roads and the cold winter weather, I suffered terribly. I could not be induced to try another trip at teaming. I was gone from home a year or more before I returned. When I did so, I found the latch string out, and my family was as glad to see me as though I had not been a very undutiful son.

In the spring of 1813, I went to Pittsburg. But my "badness" had not been fully "sweated" out of me for I again "told" away my nephew. We reached Pittsburg. I was employed to go on a boat up the Allegheny. I afterwards followed boating to some advantage, financially.

In 1818, when twenty one years of age, I purchased and paid for 160 acres of land in Guernsey, owned a horse and a cow and some other property. On the 19 day of November (Guernsey court record - 26th of November) I married Rebecca Warden and we have had twelve children, viz: John, Hugh Clark, Jr., Ellen, Elizabeth, Isaac, Mary, Nancy and William twins, Mahala, Susannah and George, all grew up to maturity but Mahala and the others married except Elizabeth and Jane who died when young women.

John married Nancy Wall in Pike County. They have eight children.

Hugh Clark married Rebecca Peniston, they had but one child Joseph Allen, they resided in Newton Township, Pike County, on Chenoweth's Fork.

Ellen married first, Samuel Wilt, by whom she had three children. He died and she married Allen Johnson, by whom she had seven or eight children, they reside in Town Township, Ross County.

Isaac married Mary Ann Toops, and removed to Iowa, where they now reside. They have nine children.

Mary married John Hanna. They have four boys. They reside in Iowa.

Nancy married Henry H. Finley. They have four children and also reside in Iowa.

William married Elizabeth O'Brien, of Pike County, moved to Kansas and died there, leaving three children.

Susannah married Silas M. Montgomery in Iowa, where they now reside with three children.

George married Mary Ann Bishop and had two children
They are all dead.

I cleared a part of my original purchase, lived on it some years, sold out, and moved to Sandusby, Ohio, where Jane died. Then came to Highland County, and then to Pike, thence to Rose County, where I resided six years. Then I bought 10 1/2 acres in Twin township, Rose County where I now reside. My wife and I reside on half of it and our son John on the other half.

In 1836 my wandering propensities returned and I was induced to visit the Indian tribes on the Red river and west and north west as far as Oregon. I was among them in company with a few other whites, more than five men.

The best land I found was in Texas, though I passed over much that tempted me to desire to own, I liked Oregon very much.

I possess some peculiarities of character, I have never called a physician to administer medicine to myself, I never had a law suit, nor do I want one. Never had any business in a court higher than a justice and then one as a witness or a juror. Have always belonged to the Democratic party. The first Presidential Candidate I voted for was Andrew Jackson. Have voted at each Presidential election since except for Martin Van Buren, and I do not vote for him because I was among the Indians and could not.

I attended school in Virginia pretty constantly and got a good start educationally speaking. I now enjoy reading and like to peruse your "Old Folks Interviewed" but never expected to be a subject of one till you came along to-day, June 12, 1875. I have never seen my name in print, nor do I know how I shall feel when I do. And I expect my companion who has traveled down the tide ^{one!}

of time with me nearly 57 years will feel as queer
as I will when she learns that I have gone and put my
name in the newspaper.

Addy Families in Coshocton County Ohio.

From the History of Coshocton Co. Ohio, Its Past and Present - 1740-1881 by N. N. Hill, Jr., Compiler, we learn of some of the Addys who came into the County as early settlers in Linton and Adams Townships. mention is made of Hugh Addy, Tom Addy, Robert and William Addy in Linton Twp.

Robert Addy came from the Virginia banks of the Patomic River in 1804 and soon afterward settled on Wills Creek in Linton Twp. In 1815/16 he moved into Adams Twp.

mention is made of two of his children, a son Anthony F. and a daughter Ellen. There probably were other children, as we find early marriages of Addy persons in the "marriage book" of Coshocton County.

William Addy, on Christmas day, Dec. 25, 1806, entered the southwest quarter of section 4 Range 4. He came from near Harpers Ferry Va. bringing 5 sons and four daughters with him.

Malachi and Enoch Jones came about the same time from Va. They married two of the Addy girls and lived on their father-in-law's place. In 1802, Regin Baker came into the County. He was born in Little York, Pa. He married Mary Addy, daughter William Addy. Aug. 3, 1813 as his second wife. His first wife and two children

At the time the Addy History was compiled we had no record for William Addy, Jr. son of William and Weather Ann (Jones) Addy. an item was found by Mrs. Robert Conner, taken from the "Guernsey Times" Cambridge, Ohio. Jan. 15, 1903. From - Shellsburg, Benton County, Iowa, and since then Census records have been found giving approximate dates of their childrens ages.

Mrs. Mary Ann (Walter) Addy was born near Baltimore, Maryland, June 15, 1819 (Walter records from Mrs. Lewis Smith give her birth as being in 1812) and died at Shellsburg, Iowa, Dec. 18, 1902.

She was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Christopher Walter, her father being a Revolutionary War Soldier. Her parents moved to Cambridge, Ohio.

On Jan. 31, 1828 she married William Addy (Jr.) who died in Shellsburg, Dec. 29, 1870.

They had six daughters and three sons.

Mrs. Addy is the last of her father's family. She located in Tama County, Iowa in 1862. Mrs. Addy was a member of the Presbyterian Church and the funeral was conducted by Rev. Mr. E. C. Haskell. Intument was made in Oakwood Cemetery.

Her family settled in Knox Township, Guernsey County, Ohio, over 90 years ago. Her sister Mrs. Hannah Ralingson lived near the same age, "Aunt Pally" as she was sometimes called was

He had been drafted in the War of 181 a short time before its termination and was on his way to the seat of war when news of peace was received.

We find in History of Coshocton County - by N. N. Hill. Linton, William Addy, on Christmas Day, of the year 1806 entered the south-west quarter of Sec. 4 Range 4 Linton Township. He was from Harper's Ferry, Virginia, and brought with him five sons and four daughters. Malachi and Enoch Jones, two brothers, came about the same time from Virginia. 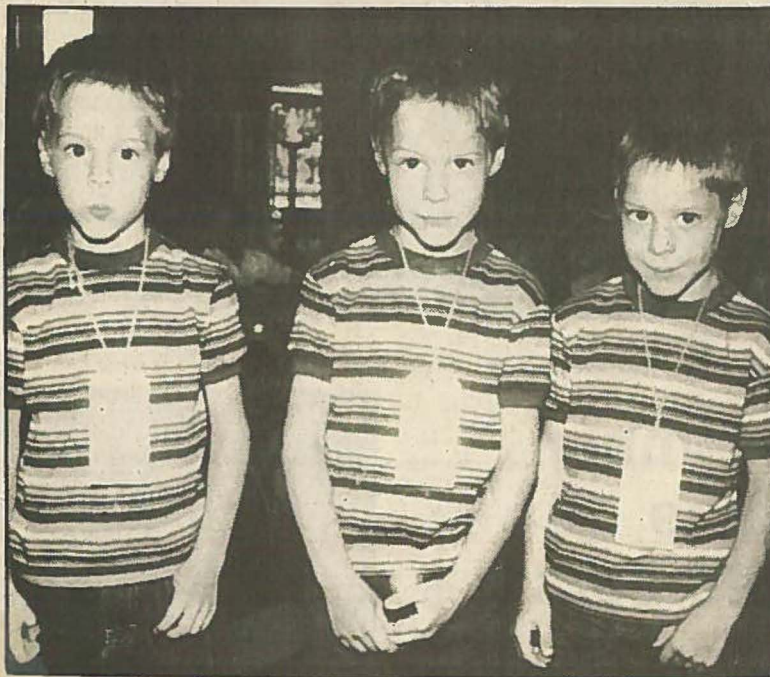
