

# Barnesville's connection to a baseball pioneer *Branch Rickey spoke at 1931 BHS commencement*

With the recent opening of "42", a movie telling the story of Jackie Robinson, the first African American player in modern Major League Baseball, the southern Ohio home county of late baseball executive Branch Rickey expects increased interest from his depiction in the movie by Harrison Ford as the baseball executive who signed Jackie Robinson to the Brooklyn Dodgers to break the color line. Rickey also has a connection to Barnesville.

In 2006, Bruce Yarnall, compiler of our popular "Twice Told Tales" and former general manager of the Enterprise, reflected that Rickey was the speaker at the 1931 Barnesville Commencement and wrote about him being profiled then in a *Washington Post* article.

In the July 2006 article, Yarnall wrote: "This year marks the 75th since Rickey, a first cousin of then school superintendent Paul V. Brown, spoke from the stage of the former Junior High Auditorium on West Church Street. Four members of that graduating

are still going strong and are expected to attend this week-end's Alumni Banquet. They are Bernita Bundy, Virginia Bailey Hunkler, Mabel Murphy Culbertson and Mildred Wilkins. It was at their commencement that probably the most famous speaker in BHS history delivered the address. Rickey was born near Portsmouth on December 20, 1881. He landed his first professional baseball contract as a catcher for the St. Louis Brown in 1905 after graduating from Ohio Wesleyan University. His short-lived professional career was described as "mediocre" at best.

By the time he came to Barnesville he was vice president and general manager of the St. Louis Cardinals baseball team having earned a law degree from the University of Michigan in the intervening years.

So who then was this famous speaker Branch Rickey? When he came to Barnesville the Cardinals had just won the 1930 World Series. They would repeat that feat five months after his Barnesville speech. His team, again, won the Series in 1942.

Also by the time of his Barnesville address, Rickey had perfected the "farm team" system, associating minor league teams that provided talent for the "Class A" Cardinals. Today, Rickey is recognized as the originator of the farm team system in place by all Major League franchises.

In addition to this, Rickey is also credited today with introducing the batter's safety helmet to the Majors.

His most famous actions, however, were to come not from his association with the Cardinals, but with the

Brooklyn Dodgers and the Pittsburgh Pirates.

Rickey was hired away from the Cards by Brooklyn in 1942. Three years later he signed Jackie Robinson to play for the Dodger's minor league affiliate in Montreal, Quebec. Rickey then purchased Robinson's contract outright officially breaking the color barrier when Robinson took the field on April 15, 1947 as the first Major League African American player.

By the '50s, Rickey moved on to Pittsburgh where, among other things, he and three businessmen founded the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. His second claim to fame came as GM for the Pirates when he drafted the first Hispanic player in the Majors, Roberto Clemente.

And, how did Barnesville receive the words of its most famous commencement speaker? Not so great as Enterprise editor Ray Palmer reported in the May 25, 1931 edition.

"The attendance was the smallest in years, many of the seats being unoccupied in strange contract to previous years when even standing room was at a premium. Attendance at the commencement was hardly as large as at the baccalaureate service the previous Sunday evening.

"The class address was delivered by Branch Rickey, vice president and general manager of the St. Louis National

league team and about nine minor league teams controlled by the St. Louis club. His subject was "A Losing Play," and his address was largely reminiscences of baseball experiences in which there was some lesson of value to the graduate.

"The theme of his address was that any success comes only through alertness, sacrifice and willingness to pay the price. Although his talk may have been as much Greek to persons unfamiliar with baseball and the "inside stuff" of

the diamond, it probably "got across" to a group of athletically-minded high school graduates in an athletic age."

Rickey collapsed in the middle of a speech in Columbia, Missouri on December 9, 1965, just shy of his 84th birthday. Two years later, the man professional baseball nicknamed "The Mahatma," was inducted into the Major League Baseball Hall of Fame.

Rickey's impact on "America's game" was profound. The success of this famous speaker at the BHS graduation of three quarters of a century ago was best described by sportswriter Jim Murray who said this of

Rickey: "He could recognize a great player from the window of a moving train!"

Rickey is buried in Rushtown Cemetery in the community of Rushtown. He is also among those featured on Portsmouth's Floodwall Murals, colorful artwork stretching along a 20-foot-tall floodwall depicting the city's history and famous figures.

Released April 12, "42" is currently showing at the Ohio Valley Mall. It was the top grossing movie in the country in its opening weekend, drawing down \$27.3 Million in ticket sales.

## 4 years added to prison term for Port man

Four years were added to a current 10-year prison term for Michael A. Rickey II, 27, of Port Washington.

Rickey, who is serving his sentence in the Madison Correctional Institution at London, went to prison earlier this year for convictions from Tuscarawas and Coshocton counties. He was sentenced to three years in prison after pleading guilty to attempted rape stemming from an incident in August 2003 in Tuscarawas County.

He received a consecutive seven-year sentence for shaking his 7-month-old daughter in Coshocton County and causing bleeding on her brain and behind her eye sockets.

In the latest case, Tuscarawas County Common Pleas Court Judge Edward O'Farrell imposed a four-year term consecutive to the 10 years for Rickey's convictions for aggravated robbery, grand theft auto and theft.

According to court records, Rickey robbed a tobacco store with a crowbar and stole two cars. Two counts of receiving stolen property were dismissed.

John Swaysey came to America around 1632. He had 2 sons: John, Jr. and Joseph. Joseph took the Freeman's Oath in Boston, MA. However, John Swaysey and his son, John Jr., refused because of their Quaker faith/religion. Thus they were banished from Salem. The two John's moved to Setauke, Long Island, and finally to Southold on the extreme end of Long Island, where they bought land and settled. John Sr. left his Salem estate (amounting to 200 pounds) to his son Joseph.

John Rickey was injured in the War of 1812. He went in for his brother Benjamin Rickey who had just gotten married. John thought this was more important than staying at home with his wife & children. Benjamin mar. Pernal Guerin or Geurin. Pernal at age 4 danced for George Washington's troops when they were stationed at her family home in Morristown, NJ. The house is now a national monument & can be viewed. Ben & Pernal (who remarried Drake) are both buried behind the Alexander Cumberland Falls Presbyt. Churchyard in Hebbardsville, OH about 12 mi. from Athens. I (Patricia Marie) have been down there twice since Stanton Rickey told me about the burial place. Stanton has also visited the home place. Stanton also visited the home place in Morristown, NJ. John Rickey would later die in mid-age at Steubenville, Jefferson Co., OH, from the wounds suffered in War of 1812.

The brother, Benjamin Rickey, is buried behind the Alexandria Cumberland Falls Presbyterian Church in Hebbardsville, OH just about 12 mi. from Athens, OH. Since Benjamin died before his wife Parnell Geurin he is buried on one side of her & her second husband, Drake, is buried on the other side.

When George was 6 months old his father moved to Athens Co., OH, where he still resides (1885) at an advanced age. Mr. Rickey's early life was spent on the farm, and his education was received at the district schools, also at the Atwood Institute, Albany, Athens Co., OH. His intentions were to fit himself for a teacher, and during the time he was attending school, he taught three winter terms in the district. At the close of his studies he was given a school and for the next 9 years he taught winter schools, and during the summer months worked for his father on the farm. Mr. Rickey was married Jan. 23, 1870 to Susan R. Bray, a daughter of John Bray, and a woman of many estimable qualities. Mrs. Rickey was born Jan. 31, 1842, in Hocking Co., now Vinton Co., OH. A short time after his marriage Mr. Rickey purchased 80 acres of land in Swan Twp., and afterwards made additions to it, having at present 131 acres. June 9, 1862, he enlisted in Company H, 87th Ohio Infantry, for 3 months, and was discharged at Camp Delaware, Ohio Oct. 1, 1862.

He participated in the battle of Harper's Ferry, and in that battle was taken prisoner. The brigade was endeavoring to hold the ferry, but were surrounded by the enemy and cut off from recruits. The conditions of the surrender were that they receive three days rations and sent back in their own lines. Aug. 9, 1863, he enlisted in the Ohio National Guards for five years, and was assigned to Co. H, 38th Regiment. In May 1864, when the call was made for the 100-days' men, he was transferred from the national guards and mustered into the United States Service, through which he served, and was discharged Sept. 3, 1864, and from the "Ohio National Guards" in May 1866. In 1860 Geo. W. Rickey united with the Protestant Methodist Church in Albany, Athens Co., OH and upon his removal to Vinton Co., Ohio transferred his membership to the Methodist Episcopal Church, situated near his residence. His wife, is also connected with and in her religious faith reared in, this church. Politically, he has associated himself with the Republican Party.

## 1931 BHS commencement speaker left legacy

### BRUCE YARNALL SPECIAL TO THE ENTERPRISE

While working recently on the "Twice Told Tales," we reported the speaker at the 1931

Barnesville Commencement was Branch Rickey. Subsequently, a recent article in the Washington Post profiling this year's Baseball Hall of Fame inductees shed more light on Rickey's most interesting life.

This year, the 75th since Rickey, a first cousin of then-school superintendent Paul V. Brown, spoke from the stage of the former Junior High Auditorium on West Church Street. Four members of that graduating class are still going strong and are expected to attend this weekend's Alumni Banquet. They are Bernita Bundy Bundy, Virginia Bailey

Hunkler, Mabel Murphy Culbertson and Mildred Wilkins. It was at their commencement that probably the most famous speaker in BHS history delivered the address.

Rickey was born near Portsmouth on Dec. 20, 1881. He landed his first professional baseball contract as a catcher for the St. Louis Brown in 1905 after graduating from Ohio Wesleyan University. His short-lived professional career was described as "mediocre" at best.

By the time he came to Barnesville he was vice president and general manager of the St. Louis Cardinals baseball team having earned a law degree from the University of Michigan in the intervening years.

So who then was this famous speaker Branch Rickey? When

he came to Barnesville the Cardinals had just won the 1930 World Series. They would repeat that feat five months after his Barnesville speech. His team, again, won the Series in 1942.

Also by the time of his Barnesville address, Rickey had perfected the "farm team" system, associating minor league teams that provided talent for the "Class A" Cardinals. Today, Rickey is recognized as the originator of the farm team system in place by all Major League franchises.

In addition to this, Rickey is also credited today with introducing the batter's safety helmet to the Majors.

His most famous actions, however, were to come not from his association with the Cardinals, but with the



Branch Rickey

Brooklyn Dodgers and the Pittsburgh Pirates.

Rickey was hired away from the Cards by Brooklyn in 1942. Three years later he

signed Jackie Robinson to play for the Dodger's minor league affiliate in Montreal, Quebec. Rickey then purchased Robinson's contract outright officially breaking the color barrier when Robinson took the field April 15, 1947, as the first Major League African American player.

By the '50s, Rickey moved on to Pittsburgh where, among other things, he and three businessmen founded the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. His second claim to fame came as GM for the Pirates when he drafted the first Hispanic player in the Majors, Roberto Clemente.

And, how did Barnesville receive the words of its most famous commencement speaker? Not so great as Enterprise editor Ray Palmer

reported in the May 25, 1931, edition.

"The attendance was the smallest in years, many of the seats being unoccupied in strange contract to previous years when even standing room was at a premium. Attendance at the commencement was hardly as large as at the baccalaureate service the previous Sunday evening.

"The class address was delivered by Branch Rickey, vice president and general manager of the St. Louis National league team and about nine minor league teams controlled by the St. Louis club. His subject was "A Losing Play," and his address was largely reminiscences of baseball experiences in which there was some lesson of value to the graduate.

"The theme of his address was that any success comes

Ricky's impact on

"America's game" was profound. The success of this famous speaker at the BHS graduation of three quarters of a century ago was best described by sportswriter Jim Murray who said this of Rickey: "He could recognize a great player from the window of a moving train!"

*Extract of a Letter from Lieutenant Rickey, dated at the Head Quarters, on the Frontiers of New Jersey, Nov. 17.*

"Sir, I have the melancholy News to tell you, that your Friend John Doty was killed, scalped and butchered in a barbarous Manner yesterday, within two Miles of the Fort; as was likewise Serjeant Mahurin; there was a Soldier with them, all on Horseback, when five Indians in Ambush fired, killed the two, and shot thro' the Soldier's Great Coat, when he immediately got down, and one of the Savages run towards him with his Tomahawk, but the Soldier fired his Piece and stopt him, then took up Doty's Piece and snapt it (for by Doty's Fall he had hurt the Lock) however he kept it presented until he mounted and rode off. This alarmed the People, but as yet we have discovered nothing more than the usual Marks, a Quantity of Blood. The Soldier is positive he killed one of them. The Inhabitants on the whole Frontier are so terrified, that they are moving; the rest gathering together, and stockading them-

selves in the best Manner they can."—*The Pennsylvania Gazette, No. 1510, December 1, 1757.*
