Introduction

In 1979, while I was attending college, I took an introduction to Anthropology course to fulfill a Social Science requirement. As a project for this course I selected to research and submit a family tree. My mom, Helen Schlarb Little, was my main source of information. She not only knew about her side of the family but also seemed to know dad's side better than he did. This was probably because mom grew up living close to her aunts, uncles and cousins. Frequent family gatherings were so much a part of her early life. Family ties were very important to her. My mom wrote down what she knew, gathered up a lot of information from her cousins and visited cemeteries to fill in birth and death dates. Her efforts formed the core of both my college project and what you see in this document. Unfortunately after college I did not pursue working on the family tree until about three and a half years ago, after both of my parents had passed away. In fact it was their passing that rekindled my interest in our family history. I wanted to preserve their memory and also pursue whom our ancestors were, what the times were like in which they lived, and where did they come from.

I choose to commemorate this, the 40th year of the Young Schlarb Thomas reunion by pulling together and presenting in this book the majority of the information I have been able to gather on the Young family line. It is, unfortunately, incomplete. I apologize for not contacting more of you in person to gather additional information for this work. I would love to hear from you now. I would also like to apologize up front for any misspellings, incomplete information and mistakes. Please feel free to call, write or e-mail me to contribute additional information or to provide corrections. I would also like to include stories that you would like to pass down to future generations. I will continue to research our family line and eventually I will publish an update. But by the very nature of this hobby it will never be 100% complete and it will be up to others, including future generations, to continue this work. At the end of this year I am planning on contributing an electronic version of the information in this book to the World Family TreeTM Project of Broderbund Software*, creator of the Family Tree MakerTM program that I use to organize this information. This will help preserve our family history in a format obtainable by other researchers and by future generations. To safeguard the privacy of people living at the time of the submittal, only our names, genders, and family links will be included.

I have been collecting copies of old pictures from family members that I have talked to. I have included some of them in the appendix of this book. I would love to see whatever other old pictures some of you may have. I may even be able to help identify who is in them if they are not marked. I have also had the opportunity to record conversations with some of you. Unfortunately I have not been able to transcribe those recordings and include them at this time.

Following this introduction this book presents some information on the origins of the Young -Schlarb -Thomas reunion. It then provides an outline of all the descendants that I have been able to find of Jacob and Phillipina Young, our immigrant ancestors. This outline presents the names, spouse's names, birth, marriage and death dates and locations if I have them. The next section is the register report for Jacob Young. It provides any detail personal or marriage information that I have gathered. Some of these details are in conflict with others. I have included all of them so that they might be sorted out at a later time. Next are several pages of photographs that I have been able to collect. These did not print out as well as I had hoped. I can provide copies of the photographs that these were scanned from or send the electronic file for use on your personal computer if you want. Following the photographs I included a family tree information submittal form for use in providing additional information. The last section is an index of people mentioned in the outline descendant tree and the register reports sections.

I have really enjoyed meeting with my relations that have contributed to this work and I look forward to hearing from many more of you. From a conversation with Chester Young and his sisters, Wilma (Young) Stahl and Eileen (Young) Hahn, at the Young - Schlarb - Thomas family reunion in June 1995: Jacob Young I was born in 1811, He married a women last name of Baab, his son Jacob II had 2 brothers, Peter and William, and two sisters. Additional information was provided in a letter to Bill Little dated 11 January 1996, from Eileen G. (Young) Hahn, West Lafayette, Ohio. In this letter Eileen stated: "Father Jacob Young I was born in Bavaria."

 From the family history book copied in December 1996 from Patty Schlarb Conway, Alliance, Ohio: Jacob Young; born 1810 in Germany. Wife: Phillipena; born 1813 in Ohio/Bavaria, Germany. Their seven children were: Phillipena (born 1836), Jacob (born 1838, died 25 February 1901, married an Elizabeth), Elizabeth (1841), Peter (1843), Caroline (1848), William (1852) and Charles (1861). All were born in Ohio.

3.) Information on "Young (Yung)" is from an article by Dorthy Evans in the 1985 History of Coshocton County, Ohio, page 405, copied at the Coshocton Library, Dec. 1996:

Jacob Young I was born 1811 in Bavaria. He came to America and settled on a farm south of Baltic in Tuscarawas County, Ohio. He was one of the founders of the Fait Church. U.S. Passenger List Indexes: In May 1998, Bill Little checked the passenger indexes for New York, NY (National Archives series M261); Baltimore, MD (M327 and M326); Philadelphia, PA (M360); and Atlantic & Gulf Coasts (M334). No matches were found for either Jacob or Phillipana Young or Jung assuming an entry year of between 1836 to 1838 based on the birth locations and ages of their first two children as listed in the 1850 census (The 1860 census listed their child Jacob, 20, as being born in Germany. Since the next child, Peter, was born in Ohio around 1843, this could imply their immigration date is somewhere between 1837 to 1843) Additional passenger lists for Boston, MA; New Orleans, LA; and "Miscellaneous Ports (Atlantic, Gulf Coast, Great Lakes)" have not yet been checked because no indexes exist for the years in question.

The daughters were: Phoebe (Young) Schlarb (b. 1865 - d. 1947), Elizabeth (Young) Thomas (b. 1866 - d. 1936) and Emma Young, twin of Karl (both b. 1880 - d. 1880). His sons were: Adam (b.1868 - d. 1939) married Elizabeth Zimmerman, Jacob (b. 1870 - d. 1949) married Ada Reiss, William (b. 1871 - d. 1957) married Sophia Marhover, Henry (b. 1873 - d. 1935) married Phoebe Marhover, John, twin, (b. 1877 - d. 1959) married Clara Neiss, Lewis, twin (b. 1877 - 1965) married Emma Miller and Charles (b. 1881

- d. 1896).

The twin sons, John and Lewis Young, purchased the home farm, which was later owned by John and wife, Clara Neiss. She was the daughter of a blacksmith. Their children are: Wilma (Young) Stahl, Eileen (Young) Hahn and Chester A. Young, present owner. Most of the Young family are members of Renner's Church and Progressive Valley Grange.

The homestead acres now graze Holstein dairy cattle. Crops are cultivated and harvested by mechanical horsepower as contrasted to the Belgium horse-power used by John and Chester A. Young (** pictured **) - These staunch German descendents have tilled this soil for over one hundred years."

He leaves a wife and six sons and two daughters, who have the sympathy of a wide circle of friends in their sore bereavement. Rev. Schemel conducted the funeral exercises, Thursday, Feb. 28th, and interment took place in the Rinner cemetery. The large concourse of sorrowing relatives and friends present at the funeral attested the high esteem in which the deceased was held. Mr. Young was a life-long Democrat, firm in political convictions and loyal to the principles he advocated; He lived an honorable upright life, and he passes from earth to that grander, nobler life, beyond the grave, respected and honored by all who knew him. He lived a useful life and exerted an influence for good which will be felt as long as his memory lingers in the hearts of those with whom in life he mingled."

The two young men are first cousins. Irvin Schlarb went from Coshocton to Camp Sherman last April. In some manner it became reported that Ernest Schlarb had been killed but his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Peter Schlarb, received no telegram to this effect. The telegram was received by the mother of Irvin Schlarb who came to Coshocton Friday and reported her son's death to the local draft board and the Red Cross headquarters. She returned to her home before she could be interviewed and the report spread that Ernest Schlarb had been killed.

Irvin Schlarb was unmarried. Both he and his cousin Ernest are nephews of Mr. and Mrs. John Lorenz, Chestnut-st. As the telephone line between West Lafayette and Chili was out of order Saturday, efforts to secure further details concerning Irvin Schlarb failed. His cousin, Harvey Schlarb, conducts a store at Chili.

Relatives of Ernest Schlarb were deeply concerned over the report that he had been killed and upon investigation received information of the mistake in the first name."
