Father?-----Believed to have started from Pennsylvania. Died or disappeared on a trip to the west to find work or to buy land. No word from him afterward. (Might have been killed by the Indians). Was traced to Tuscarawas Co. Ohio by the family.

Mother?-----Died at Newcomerstown, Ohio, date * _____ ?
Buried in an unmarked grave in a now abandoned cemetery near the intersection of the railroads on Bridge Street. All records of this cemetery was destroyed by fire.

Children:Thought to be seven or nine, Were cared for by Jonathan Evans and Robert Griffiths Families after the death of the Mother. At least some of the younger children were. The Evans Family came to Tuscarawas Co. in 1834, according to the "History of Tuscarawas County" by J. B. Mansfield, published in 1884 by Warner, Beers, and Company of Chicago, Ill.

Order of Birth of Children is not known.

Bernard Cunningham - Listed in the 1840 Census as a head of a family. Also signed with Jonathan Evans an agreement for the indenture of Catherine Cunningham for her keep. This is from a scrap of tattered paper containing part of the agreement. (In possession of Charles and Anna Cunningham. The year is missing)

Francis Cunningham - - born in Pennsylvania according to the 1860 census, also see following pages.

Elizabeth Cunningham - Married Nicholas Tharett
June 17, 1849 by Emanuel Greenwalde

Isabelle Cunningham - The Griffiths bought shoes for her. She was also on the school lists. (She is now not thought to be of our family)

Rebecca Cunningham - The Griffiths bought shoes for her. She also was on the school lists.

Ellen Cunningham - Married John Ferris
Nov. 27, 1853 by E. Z. Jacobs

Joseph Cunningham - a letter to brother Francis Cunningham in possession of Charles Cunningham, Sr.

John Cunningham - Some one pencilled his name in one of the old printed copies of the History of the Everhart and Cunningham Family.

From Bessie Cunningham Wolverton's Records

Father Cunningham _____, left Pennsylvania to find work in the "west" and was not heard of afterwards. It is thought he might have been killed by the Indians.

Mother Cunningham, _____, with her family came west in search of the father and traced him as far as Tuscarawas County where she settled. She was familiar with herb doctoring and went around the country in a horse and buggy caring for her patients. It was on one of these trips that she rode through the rain and contracted pneumonia and died. She was buried in an unmarked grave at Newcomerstown, Ohio, near the intersection of the railroads on Bridge Street. When the Cleveland and Marietta Railroad (now belongs to the Pennsy) was built some of the graves had to be moved. Very few of the stones of the graves of the part of cemetery that was left undisturbed are still remaining and probably unreadable. This railroad was built about 1871 or 1872. All the town records were destroyed in the 1920's and 1930's so no records can be found of the ones buried in this cemetery.

Mother Cunningham must have been very well read to be able to understand the medical instructions in her "doctor book". "The American New Dispensatory" by James Thacher, M. D. - 4th edition - Boston -, Thomas E. Wait, publisher and Joseph W. Graham, printer published 1821. (At present in possession of Walter Ray Cunningham)

There is thought to be either seven or nine children and all evidently born in Pennsylvania. The 1830 census of Salem and Oxford Townships, Tuscarawas County, Ohio, does not show any Cunninghams.

The 1840 Census of Salem Township, Tuscarawas County, Ohio shows a Bernard Cunningham as head of a family with one male under five years of age, one male under ten years of age, one male under 15 years of age, and one male under thirty years of age. One female under five years of age, two females under ten years of age, and one female under 15 years of age. If this is our family, then Mother Cunningham must have died before 1840, and the family must have come from Pennsylvania after 1834, since that is the birth date of one of the later children as far as we are sure. (Catherine).

The order of the birth of the children is not known yet. We have only the birth date of Francis and Catherine Cunningham from their Bible records, and Elizabeth's birth date from a tombstone in New Phila

Francis Cunningham, son of Father and Mother Cunningham (Given names unknown) has the earliest date of birth which we know so we will list him first.

(From an old book record of the minutes of the School Board meetings for School District No. 3, Salem Township, Tuscarawas County, Ohio.) The first page is dated July 3, A. D., 1838. This is a record of the minutes of all the meetings of the board for various reasons. Francis Cunningham's name first appeared June 15, 1852 as director, filling the place of Daniel McConnel. The last notation in the book was made and dated April 10, 1871. Francis Cunningham's name seems to have been on the board all that time.

From the History of Tuscarawas County, Ohio by J. B. Mansfield in a list of Justices of the Peace I find the name of Francis Cunningham listed for the years, 1856 and 1858. Also among his personal papers in the possession of Charles and Anna Cunningham we found several pages of people that he had married.

In the year of 1850 Francis Cunningham was married to Sarah Everhart who was active in Church work for the Union and Salem Methodist Churches.

Sarah Everhart was born in Ohio. The daughter of David Everhart and Rachel Hicks Everhart.

David Everhart's name appears in the 1830 Census for Coshocton County, Ohio.

In the 1850 Census Francis Cunningham is listed as a Shoemaker. And his account books show that he made and repaired boots and shoes for many of his community. W. I. Shannon often remarked what a well fitting pair of boots his uncle Francis Cunningham had made for him when he was a young man living in Ohio.

In the 1860 Census Francis Cunningham's name appeared as a Farmer and his will shows that he had quite a bit of land at the time of his decease.

Francis Cunningham and his wife Sarah are buried at the Mount Zion Cemetery of Salem Township, Tuscarawas Co. Ohio. His grave is marked and has been checked to show that he died March 3, 1897, age seventy years and seventeen days. Sarah Cunningham died April 3, 1881 age forty-nine years.

From the "History of the Everhart and Cunningham Families" published for the Everhart Cunningham Reunion Sept. 12, 1914, I have copied the following:

"Little is known of our ancestors farther back than about 1810. Francis Cunningham, well known as Squire Cunningham of Lick Run served the people in the capacity of squire for something like thirty years. Always known as a man, quiet, orderly, and deliberate in the judgement of cases that came before him for settlement in his office as squire, and often being called to sit as juror in Common Pleas Court of Tusc. County, where he resided up until his death.

From stories and Notes at Anna Cunningham' Home.

Father Cunningham left Pennsylvania with two other men to buy land or find work in the west. When he failed to write or return his wife-Catherine Cunningham brought the children and came to the vicinity of what is now Newcomerstown, Ohio. There is also a story told that it was written in a Book, but so far we have been unable to relocate the book.

Recently Anna Cunningham came across the following:
Grandmother Book.

Rebecka Cunningham - - written in a page in a book -

"The Principles of Practices of Obstetricy"

by Thomas Castle, M. D. Fls.

Member of Trinity College, Cambridge, Etc., Etc.

Stereotyped and Published by Duff Geen - 1834

Since she was traditionally a Doctor, this could possibly also be her book. But again we lack the entire evidence. I know that if she understood even parts of that book she must have been well educated, Even if she did not seem to be a graduate Doctor (as we can find no Dr. Cunningham listed for that locality.)

She followed her husband to the vicinity of what is now Newcomerstown, Salem Township, Tuscarawas Co., Ohio. Here she lost trace of her husband and she settled. She must have brought the following children with her : Bernard, John, Catherine, Francis, Isabella, and Joseph. She died at the home of one of her patients on Evans Creek near Old Taylor's Church on what is now State Route 75.

(There is also a story that said another doctor was present at the time and he refused to let her have her own Medicine Case or to let her take her own medicine and she died and was buried near there.)

We don't have the order of the children's birth. Jonathan Evans raised the one daughter, Catherine. Catherine was born October 15, 1834, married Feb. 15, 1855 to Isaac Shannon of nearby Bakersville, O.

(The Shannon's in this book are their descendants.) Catherine Cunningham Shannon died Nov. 28, 1861.

Francis Cunningham was born Feb. 14, 1827; died March 3, 1897. married Sarah Everhart on April 11, 1850. Sarah Everhart was born Sept. 11, 1831; died April 3, 1881. Both are buried at what is now Mount Zion Cemetery, Salem Township, Tusc. Co., Ohio.

In an old album we had some pictures taken in Lawrence, Kansas with names of J.B.C., Francis M., Lester B, Catherine Henry L. Ella M, & Katie Viola. The following is an excerpt from her reply:

Dear Mrs. Cunningham:

Sept. 13, 1945

Since receiving your letter I have tried to find out if the man named "Cunningham", our little town is named for, is any relative of your husband's. Haven't had much success along that line, but I am enclosing a clipping from the Hutchinson News-Herald of Sunday Sept. 2. Hutchinson, Kans. is just fifty miles from us. This is a daily paper and we like it so much for it sure does get the "news". I just happened to be looking on the society page and noticed the name - compared it with your letter, saying the pictures in the album were from the gallery of A. C. Hamilton, Lawrence, Kans. and the names written on the back were J.B.C., Francis M., Lester P., F.B., etc. You notice this clipping is F. B. and you notice they were married at Lawrence. Now I believe if you write them at Nickerson you may be able to locate some more of your folks. Nickerson is just west of Hutchinson a few miles.

They corresponded until about Christmas of 1950. Cora Cunningham died in Aug., 1951. For a year or so Christmas cards were exchanged with the daughter, Helen Cunningham Fossey, but nothing more about the family was learned. Everyone was too busy to take time to hunt for more data and put it down on paper.

In a letter to Mrs. W. Ray Cunningham from Mrs. Rev. Fred B. Cunningham dated Nov. 10, 1945 was the following information concerning "Aunt Ellen's" family.

"You ask about Aunt Ellen Ferris - when they came to Kansas they had nine children - five of whom died inside of a year's time. Mary married a Dr. Packer - they had one child. Lillie married a Dr. Logan they went to Oregon-do not know how many children they had. Will married a Catholic girl-do not know anything about his family. Joe, have not seen for years. Uncle John Ferris was a section foreman for years there at Lecompton. He was Irish and would fight at the drop of a hat."

"An after that! I forgot to tell you one thing about Aunt Ellen. She was a great hand to visit and nurse the sick and in her younger days I don't think there was a stork party but what she was invited. She was with me when my first child was born. She was a very good woman."

That was a mistake in the paper - we were married in Lecompton, Kans. My name was Cora Day."

Fred. B. Cunningham preached in the North West Kansas Conference of the Methodist Church from 1913 to 1931. His wife, Cora Day Cunningham came from Ohio near Gallion and Corsica. Her mother's brother was a Methodist minister - Rev. Joe McFarland.

... .. "You ask if I knew why Joe C. came to Kansas -nothing only there seemed to be a good opening here. He owned a good farm a mile south of Lecompton. When the boys were old enough to do the work he would leave them to do the farming and he would go away to plaster. The last time he was away he came home sick - he had typhiod fever. Mother C. cared for him as long as she was able -then took to her bed with it and she died - was 52. Both girls had it. In later years Father C. was out in the field in the spring burning trash and got afire. Very nearly burned to death. Died later from the burns."

John Cunningham folk are all well and he still lives at Shueyville and is getting along very well for the chanse he has. They have an increas in his family is a boy too weaks old. They now have three children living and ded. Land is very low her to. the crops was good last season here except the corn was hit with frost which hirt it along the low land and on the high prarie the corn was not hirt enny hardly... .. I hop som... .. (the rest was on the prices of products and I did not have time to copy it all)

Find land records in Coshocton County for Isaac Shannon from 1850 to 1859, so they must have remained in Ohio that long.

William Shannon was born in Orange County, Indiana, and Isaac Shannon enlisted in the Civil War from Indiana. After he was gone and William was born Isaac's father, William Shannon, came from Ohio in a springwagon with a team and took Catherine and Mary and baby William back to Ohio, with all the household goods that he could haul in the spring wagon. Isaac Shannon died on forced march, of Army Disentery on Nov. 2, 1861. His grave is not known as workers followed the army and buried the dead. Catherine Cunningham Shannon died of Typhoid Fever on Nov. 28, 1861, never having been told of her husband's death.

She was a beautiful seamstress and a good house keeper. Mary Smith said she always made her sit on a chair while eating any food so as not to scatter crumbs around. I have seen a very beautiful quilt she made. The stitches were so even and close that it looked like there was a cord run between the row of stitches. Indeed, very lovely. (P. Brookins Catherine Cunningham born Oct. 15, 1834 in Pa.; Died Nov. 28, 1861 in Ohio. Married in Tuscarawas County, Ohio on Feb. 15, 1855 to Isaac Shannon, born July 17, 1832 in Ohio; Died Nov. 2, 1861 (Civil War).
