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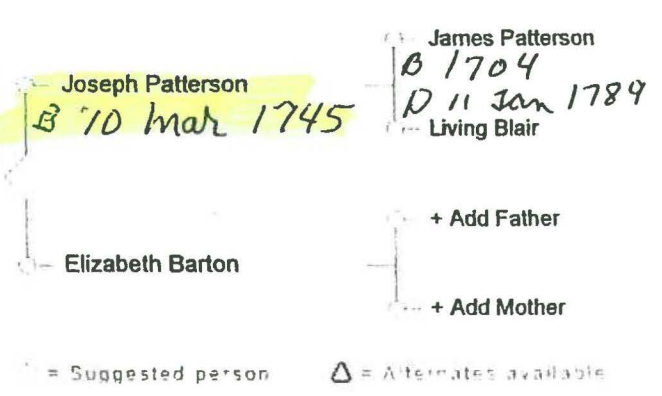

Dear Cousin Ellen,

I would be glad to hear from anyone connected with the Patterson line.

If the information comes up during the searching for old cemeteries, I am interested in the location of the grave site, of Archibald Clark Sr. His daughter Elizabeth married my James Patterson. He is supposed to be buried near Warsaw, OH.

I just returned from a quick trip to New Jersey last Friday, where I only had two days to do research in three different cities. I believe the Patterson's were in Monmouth Co. and then later in Middlesex Co. before going on to Pa. Daniel's mother Elizabeth was supposed to have married a Mr. Luke in NJ. and while searching the Colonial Marriage Bonds, the only Luke I could find listed had married an Elizabeth Parrison. I wonder if it could be a misspelling of Patterson? Some day I hope to prove it one way or the other. This was found at Trenton, NJ. In the State Archives, on microfilm.

When I got to Bedford, Co. PA. I had better luck, I found Daniel Patterson, listed on tax rolls for 1799 and 1802, but not for 1804. I assume they had left for Greene Co. PA. by 1804. Daniel is listed under inmates, which I found out means that he was a renter and not in jail as I first thought. In 1799 Daniel had one horse and one cow valued at \$26.00 and was taxed at 7 cents. I didn't have time to stop in Greene Co. this time as we had to be home Friday night.

Joseph Patterson Elizabeth Barton

C., James R., Elias A., William R., Stout H., Elza L., and Josephine N. are living. Mr. Patterson's great grandfather, Joseph, was of Scotch-Irish descent. His wife, Elizabeth Barton, was an English lady. He died while an officer on a ship at sea. His widow married a Mr. Luke, and settled in New Jersey. Daniel Patterson and Hannah Heavens were the parents of Stout Patterson, Sr., and Jonathan and Mary (Lanute) Stiles were Mrs. Patterson's parents. Her father was born in Virginia in 1775, and died in 1861. Her mother was born in 1778 and died in 1835. They had fourteen children.

In writing the simple annals of a quiet and unobtrusive man like William Clippinger, much can not be said to interest the stranger, but those who had the honor of his acquaintance will read with pleasure the record of his life. His father, George, was born in Westmoreland county, Pennsylvania, in 1781, and his mother, Betsey (Smith), in 1779. Both died in 1835. After purchasing the land now owned by his son William, he and a son built a cabin, and partly cleared the little farm before moving the family here in 1820. Before his death his farm of fifty acres had increased to one hundred and fifty-seven acres, all paid for. He had seven children, viz: Polly, Joseph, Sarah, William, George, Jr., David, and Israel. Sarah and David are dead. George resides in Indiana, Polly in Morgan county, Ohio, and the remaining three in this county. William Clippinger was born in Pennsylvania August 11, 1812. In 1837 he married Mrs. Norris, daughter of William and Annie (Stone) McCrory. By her he had five children: Sarah Ann, wife of C. P. Forsythe; Elizabeth, wife of Daniel Thompson; Betsey, deceased, and two that died in infancy. Mr. Clippinger is a cooper by trade, and worked hard at that business for many years.

Isaac McCollum was born in New Jersey November 1, 1802. In 1819 he came to Center township, and lived here until his death in 1876, from paralysis. His wife was Nancy Grey, who was born in Camden, New Jersey, March 10, 1805. Their marriage occurred on April 27, 1831. Their children were: Alexander, James, Mary, John; Amanda, deceased; Henry Harrison, deceased; Isaac, Miller, and a dead infant. The survivors are living in this county. Miller McCollum, eighth child of Isaac and Nancy

Grey McCollum, was born on August 31, 1845, on the homestead, which has since been his home. His boyhood was not notable for any unusual incident until his eighteenth year, when he enlisted in Company H, Twelfth Ohio cavalry, and served from September, 1863, to July, 1865. During the struggle at Mt. Sterling, Kentucky, he was wounded in the right thigh, and in a subsequent engagement at Saltville, West Virginia, he was shot through both legs. On October 2, 1864, he was taken prisoner, and endured the hardships of life in Libby prison until February 5, 1865. Mr. McCollum is a practical farmer. On March 17, 1868, he married Sarah Rebecca Noble, daughter of William Francis and Elizabeth Dugan Noble, of Center township. She was born on January 30, 1846, in Center township. Their children are: Charles Homer, born April 7, 1869; Franklin Clay, born August 31, 1871; Ernest Carey, born July 27, 1873; Mary Grace, born July 25, 1875; Anna Lena, born April 24, 1877, and Eva Maud, born September 9, 1879. Mr. McCollum has been township clerk three terms. He is a Presbyterian in religious belief, and in politics is a Republican.

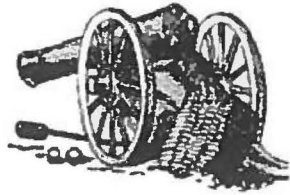

This regiment was organized at Zanesville, McConnellsville and Somerton from Sept. 17 to Dec. 24, 1861, to serve for three years. In Jan., 1862, it went by rail to Cumberland, Md., and there joined the forces under the command of Brig-Gen. Lander, then in camp at Patterson's creek. After a summer spent in strenuous activity in Virginia, in December it made several reconnaissances from Suffolk to Blackwater, in one of which a heavy skirmish was had with the enemy.

I Cant harkly use my right arm to day and write the best news out there We would be glad to hear from you all soon and how Mother is tell Mother to Keep in good spiretts i want to see her. Sarygane is Married to a man his name of James Cross, he lives six miles from here she has got a fine Daughter 8 months old its name Harriett Bell

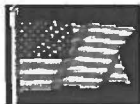

home; while the third, Martha, is the wife of J. W. Armstrong, of Jefferson township. Mr. Clark was justice of the peace for Jefferson township for three years from 1858. He owns one hundred and seventy-one acres of land, located in section eight, Center township.

Among the hardy sons of toil that the Emerald isle has contributed to help build up this mighty nation is John Boyd, a native of county Antrim, who was born February 10, 1818. His parents and a sister (Jane) left their native shores in the month of August, 1832, to seek in the now world that liberty and prosperity which was denied them at home. After a two weeks stay in the metropolis of America they settled in Center township. His father was James Boyd, and his mother, Jane (Crawford) Boyd. The elder Boyd was born in 1765, and died in 1850; his wife was born in 1780 and died in 1857. In 1840 John Boyd and Susan Scott were married. She was born in Pennsylvania, October 14, 1820, and came to this county with her parents, Francis and Elizabeth (Hunter) Scott, natives of Ireland. Ten children (eight living) have been born to them--Elizabeth Jane, and Josephine are deceased; James S., Francis S., Margaret, Nancy J., Samuel N., Susan E., Sarah Ann, and John Boyd, Jr., are yet living. Mr. Boyd has been justice of the peace for twenty-one years, treasurer, trustee, etc. His time has, indeed, been well spent, and the possession of four hundred and thirty-two acres of land, well improved, and the good will of his community will make his old age comfortable.

A brief sketch of the senior Patterson will appropriately precede that of Stout Patterson, Jr. Stout Patterson, Sr., was well named, for he was one of those stout hearted pioneers who went far beyond the ramparts of civilization, into the then dreary region known as the "Ohio Wilderness," to carve out for himself and family the rude comforts of an isolated home. He was born in Greene county, Pennsylvania, in 1786, and died October 7, 1851. His wife was born in the same county in 1789, and died in 1846. Her name was Mary Rose Patterson. In 1808, when few had dared to brave the dangers of a frontier life, this stout hearted couple settled in section six of Center township. They bought forty acres of land, now owned by Elijah Warné,

and lived on it until they died. Two of their eleven children are yet living-- Julia Ann, wife of Elijah Warne, and Stout Patterson, Jr., who was born March 17, 1819. August 18, 1843, Rebecca Noble, daughter of Thomas and Julia Noble, gave him her hand in marriage. Their only child died when four months old. The mother was born in March, 1823, and died April 31, 1845. In June, 1846, Mr. Patterson married Miss Deborah Stiles; she was born October 9, 1822, in Jefferson township. Eight of the ten children of this marriage are living--John L. and Mary A. are dead; Margaret Eliza, Joseph C., James R., Elias A., William R., Stout H., Elza D., and Josephine N. are living. Mr. Patterson's great grandfather, Joseph, was of Scotch-Irish descent. His wife, Elizabeth Barton, was an English lady. He died while an officer on a ship at sea. His widow married a Mr. Luke, and settled in New Jersey. Daniel Patterson and Hannah Heavens were the parents of Stout Patterson, Sr., and Jonathan and Mary. (Lanutz) Stiles were Mrs. Patterson's parents. Her father was born in Virginia in 1775, and died in 1861. Her mother was born in 1778 and died in 1833. They had fourteen children.

In writing the simple annals of a quiet and unobtrusive man like William Clippinger, much can not be said to interest the stranger, but those who had the honor of his acquaintance will read with pleasure the record of his life. His father, George, was born in Westmoreland county, Pennsylvania, in 1781, and his mother, Betsey (Smith), in 1779. Both died in 1835. After purchasing the land now owned by his son William, he and a son built a cabin, and partly cleared the little farm before moving the family here in 1820. Before his death his farm of fifty acres had increased to one hundred and fifty-seven acres, all paid for. He had seven children, viz: Polly, Joseph, Sarah, William, George, Jr., David, and Israel. Sarah and David are dead. George resides in Indiana, Polly in Morgan county, Ohio, and the remaining three in this county. William Clippinger was born in Pennsylvania August 11, 1812. In 1837 he married Mrs. Norris, daughter of William and Annie (Stone) McCrory. By her he had five children: Sarah Ann, wife of C. P. Forsythe; Elizabeth, wife of Daniel Thompson; Betsey, deceased, and two that died in infancy.

CHAPTER XXIII

Center Township

CENTER has an area of about twenty-three square miles, and is the smallest of the townships, excepting Valley. The name indicates its location in the county. When formed in 1822, the township was larger than it is today.

Early Settlers.—John Chapman was probably the first white person to settle within the present boundaries of Center township. He built a cabin on Endley's run, the stream that crosses the National Road at the foot of the east slope of the Four-mile hill. He was a squatter on government land, and engaged in hunting and trapping. (For further information about this pioneer see the stories entitled "Hole-in-the-Ear," "An Indian Story," and "Legend of the Lead Mine.")

Warne has long been a familiar name in Center township. Thomas Warne, the first of the family in Guernsey county, came from New Jersey into what is now Wills township very early in the century, and in 1812 he settled on land that is now in Center. Mr. Warne was drowned while on his way to Stillwater where he was going to procure funds to prosecute the family's claims to a large estate in New Jersey. His son, Jonathan Warne, born in 1791, was the father of nine children, some of whose descendants are now living in the township.

Born in Pennsylvania, in 1786, Stout Patterson settled on section six of Center township, in 1808. George Clippinger settled in the township, in 1820; Isaac McCollum, in 1819; Alexander and Joseph Eagleson, in 1830; and William Thompson, in 1820.

Old Folks of 1876.—In 1876 the following aged persons were living in the township: Elizabeth Boyd, James Dugan, Mrs. James Dugan, Joseph Eagleson, Martha Eagleson, James Eagleson, Katherine Eagleson, Nero Gilson, Joseph Griffith, Mary Kendall, John Luzadder, Hugh Miller, Nancy McCollum, Martha Patterson, Benjamin Simpson and James Spence.

Crossed by Zane's Trace.—In 1798 Zane's Trace was blazed through what is now Center township. It entered a few rods west of Old Washington, turned northwest about a mile, then continued its course westward parallel to the present National Road. It crossed the ridge north of the Four-mile hill.

George Beymer purchased two hundred acres of land on Zane's Trace, in 1803, and built a double log house on Endley's run, a few rods north of the present National Road. In 1806 he opened his house as a tavern. As

his family on and erected a cabin. The trip was made, with great danger, in a wagon all the way from Pennsylvania. Within a few years he had cleared up a hundred and sixty acres and purchased more land and built a saw and grist-mill on Leatherwood creek, the first within Centre township.

Alexander Egleson was born in Ireland in 1783 and came to Pennsylvania in 1819 and to Centre township in 1830. He and his family became substantial and well-to-do farmers of this county.

In 1841 came Samuel Nelson and wife from Pennsylvania, their native state, and located in Centre township and here they reared a worthy and industrious family.

Thomas and Ann (Pursely) Warne emigrated from New Jersey to Ohio in 1802 and located in Wills township first, then moved to Muskingum county, but in 1812 returned to Guernsey county, settling in Centre township. Their log cabin home was once surrounded by water during a flood and the family were removed on horseback. Mr. Warne was drowned while on a trip to Stillwater, where he had gone to procure funds with which to prosecute his claims for a large estate in the East. He reared a large and highly respected family of sons and daughters.

Ireland furnished another sturdy son for the settlement of Centre township, in the person of John Boyd, born in Antrim, 1818. His parents and sister left for America in 1832 to seek a home in free America, and after two weeks in the city of New York, landed in Centre township as soon as they could well make the trip. The father was James Boyd.

✕ Stout Patterson was among the hardy pioneers of this township. He was known as Sr. Patterson and his son as Stout, Jr. The father was born in Greene county, Pennsylvania, as was his good wife. They bought and paid for forty acres of land in this township and there they reared a family, lived and finally died. They came here in 1808, hence were truly "first settlers" in Guernsey county.

William Clippinger is another pioneer who must not be omitted in Centre township settlement. He was born in Westmoreland county, Pennsylvania, in 1781 and his wife in 1779; both died in 1835. He and his son William erected a rude log house and partly cleared up a small farm tract before moving the family here. At the time of his death, he had bought and paid for one hundred and fifty-seven acres.

Isaac McCollum was born in New Jersey in 1802, moved to Centre township in 1819 and lived here until overtaken by death. A son of this gentleman, Grey McCollum, served in the Twelfth Ohio Volunteer Infantry during two years of the Civil war and was twice wounded and finally taken prisoner

with which to prosecute the claims of the family to a share in a large estate in New Jersey. He was the father of Jonathan Warne, who was born in New Jersey October 30, 1791, and died July 19, 1855. His wife, Martha (Luzader) Warne, was born in Pennsylvania December 17, 1799, and died in June, 1856. They were married September 25, 1815. Their family consisted of nine children, three of whom are deceased—Jonathan, DeWitt C., John, Elijah, Mary Ann, and Nancy. DeWitt C. Warne married Jane Wills, and has had six children, five of whom are living—Edward, Jennie F., Charlie Ross, Agnes, and DeWitt Clinton, Jr. Jonathan is deceased. John Warne was born October 30, 1833, and married Mary Wicup, who was born in Muskingum county May 26, 1841. Their three children are: Annie, Martha, and Hattie.

Andrew Clark was born in Jefferson township, Guernsey county, September 23, 1820. He was the son of William and Elizabeth (Baird) Clark, who emigrated from Washington county, Pennsylvania, about the year 1815, and located in Jefferson township for a short time in about 1817. They afterwards lived in Liberty township for two years, and then returned to Jefferson township and settled on the farm now owned by Henry McClary, where they remained during the rest of their lives. William Clark and his wife were born in the same year, month, and day—March 3, 1797. He died while yet in middle life, on January 11, 1849, having survived his wife, who died September 29, 1842. On August 25, 1846, Andrew Clark and Miss Nancy B. Forsythe were married. She was born October 10, 1821, in Liberty township, this county. To them were born three children. One of these, Eliza Ann, married Alexander Patterson, who lives in Center township; another, Sarah Jane, lives at home; while the third, Martha, is the wife of J. W. Armstrong, of Jefferson township. Some old maps indicate it as a place of importance on Zane's Trace.

Population Was 200.—That the founder had visions of a great metropo-

He brought it to the writer, remarking that it might contain something that should be preserved in Guernsey county history.

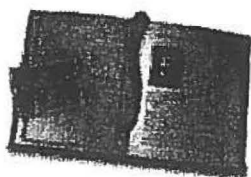

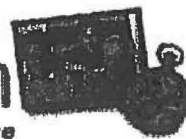

On this *1st* day of *March*, 1894, at *New Comerstown*, County of *Furcarawas* State of *Ohio*, before me, *A. Fegethoff*, a Special Examiner of the Pension Office, personally appeared *Gilbert L. Patterson*,

who, being by me first duly sworn to answer truly all interrogatories propounded to him during this Special Examination of aforesaid pension claim, deposes and says: *I am 54 years old, a farmer, P. O. addr. as above.*

I am brother of Thomas J. Patterson, the claimant. Before the late War and up to the time of its commencement we boys, Thomas J. Daniel and myself were all living at home with our parents. I enlisted August 1862 in Co. D. 52nd O.V.I. and was discharged in June 1865.

My brother Thomas J. enlisted in Co. B. 80th O.V.I.

Q. *Was your brother Thomas J. ever hurt sometime before the War, by a boy named Thomas Knowles, hitting him with a stone in the face.*

A. *I have no recollection of anything of that kind; it may have occurred but I know nothing about it.*

Q. *Do you know that your brother Thomas J. is blind in one eye?*

A. *Yes I know that.*

Q. *In which eye is he blind?*

A. *I think it is his right eye which is blind.*

Q. *When did you first learn that he is blind in one eye?*

A. *When I came home from the army.*

Q. *Did he ever tell you when and how he lost the sight of that eye?*

A. *No sir he did not.*

Q. *Did he ever complain of any affection or failing of sight of an eye, or eyes, before he enlisted?*

A. *No to the best of my knowledge.*

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DEPOSITION N.

Case of Thomas J. Patterson, No. 432654

On this 3 day of March, 1894, at Newcomertown, County of Fuscarawan State of Ohio, before me, A. Tegethoff, a Special Examiner of the Pension Office, personally appeared Daniel Patterson, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer truly all interrogatories propounded to him during this Special Examination of aforesaid pension claim, deposes and says: I am 52 years old, a farmer.

P.O. addr. as above.

I am a brother of the claimant Thomas J. Patterson. My two brothers, Thomas and Gilbert and myself were living living with our parents before the War and up to the commencement of the War.

Yes sir I remember well when my brother Thomas and two other boys were playing by along the Canal. Thomas and myself were standing on one side of the Canal and the other two boys, two brothers, Thomas and John Knowles were on the other side of the Canal. This was near back about 2 1/2 miles from Newcomertown.

One of the boys, Thomas Knowles, picked up a cud stone and said, "just watch me, I can hit Thomas Patterson right in the eye," and he threw the stone and sure enough hit Thomas right in the outside corner of the eye.

Yes sir he cut the bone just near the side of the eye and it drew the blood I think. But I would not be positive of the fact that it made the blood come.

No sir I do not remember that I gave Thomas Knowles a thrashing for hitting my brother.

No sir, my brother did not go home to have the wound attended to. I think my brother remained with us. As far as I know this being hit with a stone as stated above

never affected the eye or the sight of the eye of my brother. No sir, not to the best of my recollection, I never accused Thomas Strowles of having injured the sight or the eye of my brother Thomas.

I do not recollect that my brother Thomas ever had any affection of his eye or eyes before he enlisted. If he had, I do not know it.

I believe it was the right eye in which the boy hit him with the stone.

No sir, I have no recollection of ever accusing Thomas Strowles of having hurt or injured the sight of my brother nor did I ever threaten him to punish him for hitting Thomas with the stone.

I never knew that there was anything wrong with Thomas' right eye till long after he had returned from the service. No sir, I saw my brother Thomas' right away after he came home from the army, but did not observe or know till a long time after his return from the army. ^{that the right eye was getting} In fact I could not tell you when I first ^{new} or learned that there was anything wrong with my brother Thomas' vision.

I have perused and the questions asked me and my answers are correctly recorded.

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for the eye; No sir, no doctor was called to examine or treat the injury after the boy had hit me. Well I remember saw the boy who hit me with the stone line here at New Comertown, his name is - Stuard.

Yes sir I was examined by some doctor at the time I was recruited into service. We were all examined at New Philadelphia, O. We did not have to strip; the examination was not very rigid.

Q. Now was your right eye at the time you enlisted?

A. The eye and the sight thereof was good when I enlisted.

Q. When did you first observe that the sight of said eye was not good?

A. I think we were out target shooting when I first noticed that the sight of said eye was not good. I do not know what had caused the blindness of the eye.

The reason why I did not apply sooner for pension of the loss of sight of said eye is, because I was doing all along a good business and did not need a pension until some 6 or 7 years ago.

Yes, sir, I am married, have a wife and one child, a daughter. My father and mother both had good sight. None of them had ever any trouble with disease of eyes or blindness; My daughter has good eyes and good sight and so have my brothers.

Q. By whom can you prove that your eyes and the sight of them was good prior to and up to the time you enlisted?

A. William Wilson, John Wilson, John Burris, Dan Mishkinin, Jim Cross all live of New Comertown. And Oliver H. Powlson of New Philadelphia, Ohio. All the above named men were also with me in the service and can testify that I lost the sight of my eye in the service.

I never received any medical treatment for my eye or eyes in service. I contracted a rheumatism in service. I had the rheumatism before I knew that I had lost the sight of my eye. I have never
