JOURNAL ENTRY OF FINAL SETTLEMENT

NOW, on the 22nd day of December, 1951, this matter comes on for hearing upon the petition of the National Bank of Topeka, Administrator, for a final settlement of said estate, the Administrator appearing by John E. Kirk, its Vice President and Trust Officer and by Lowrance, Stumbo and Irwin, attorneys for said Administrator. Roy L. Bulkley appeared as guardian ad litem for Albert Judson Rutland, a minor, and as attorney for such heirs as may be in the military service of the United States and there were no other appearances. Thereupon, the Administrator shows to the Court and the Court finds that notice of said hearing has been given by publication and mailing as provided by law and by the orders of this Court and that proof thereof has been duly filed herein, and said notice and proof thereof are hereby examined and approved by the Court.

Thereupon, the Administrator did file herein its Supplemental Final Account.

Thereupon, the Petition for Final Settlement was submitted to the Court and the Court, having considered said petition, heard the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, finds that letters of administration were granted to the National Bank of Topeka on the 17th day of February, 1951 and that it published its notice of appointment February 20, 1951, that more than nine months has expired since the publication of such notice and more than one year has expired since date of death and that the time for filing claims against said estate has expired.

The Court further finds that said estate has been fully administered, that all demands of creditors against said estate have been paid in full by the Administrator, that inheritance taxes due the State of Kansas have been paid as herein

day of November, 1950, and was, at the time of her death, a resident of Topeka, Shawnee County, Kansas and a citizen of the United States. That she was a single woman at the time of her death and left no children, either natural or adopted, or any child or children of prior deceased children, either natural or adopted.

That Guy J. Mulvane and Josephine Hollis were the father and mother, respectively, of the said Hazel M. Verity and they had but two children, namely, the decedent herein, Hazel M. Verity and a son, Paul S. Mulvane, who died in infancy.

That Josephine Hollis, mother of the decedent, had two brothers and one sister, namely, Albert H. Hollis, Oscar Hollis and Mary E. Hollis and that the said Albert H. Hollis, Oscar Hollis and Mary E. Hollis died without issue, either natural or adopted.

That Guy J. Mulvane, father of the decedent herein, was the son of James Mulvane and Betsy Cobb. That the said James Mulvane and Betsy Cobb had nine children, namely, Phineas Mulvane, Elizabeth Mulvane, Ralph Mulvane, Catherine Mulvane, Margaret Mulvane, Sarah Mulvane, James K. Mulvane, Polly Mulvane and Guy J. Mulvane.

That Phineas, Elizabeth, Catherine and Polly Mulvane died without issue.

That Ralph Mulvane predeceased the said Hazel M. Verity and left one son, namely, Ralph P. Mulvane, who is a first cousin of the decedent.

That Margaret Mulvane had two children, namely, Byron Clyde Mitchener and Ray Mulvane. That Ray Mulvane died in infancy and Byron Clyde Mitchener, who predeceased the said Hazel M. Verity, had six children, namely, Wayne J. Mitchener, Margaret Henry, Judith Lodenhamper, Winefride Hardesty, John Mitchener and William Mitchener. That said William Mitchener died in infancy.

That Sarah Mulvane had two children, namely Maude Scott and Ethel Sinclair. That the said Ethel Sinclair predeceased the decedent herein and had one son, namely, Ralph Dillon.

That James K. Mulvane had three children, namely, Albert R. Mulvane, Phineas F. Mulvane and Emily Elizabeth Mulvane. That the said Emily Elizabeth Mulvane

That the said Hazel M. Verity left surviving her as her sole and only heirs at law, the following persons who did thereupon inherit and become vested with those interests in all the property of her estate, which is set opposite the names of said persons, to wit:

Bulkley, a practicing attorney of Topeka, Kansas, has been appointed by the Court as guardian ad litem for said minor and as attorney for such of the heirs as may be in the military service of the United States, has duly filed his answer herein and should be allowed for his services so rendered, the sum of \$10.00.

The Court further finds that the Administrator has paid the State Inheritance Taxes upon the following distributive shares and which should be and hereby are charged to each distributee as follows, to wit:
