Suzanne Deeslie Pierce

A funeral mass for Suzanne Deeslie Pierce, 77, of Navasota, was celebrated 10 a.m. Wednesday, March 20, at Christ Our Light Catholic Church with Rev. Paul G. Felix as the celebrant. The rite of committal followed in Oakland Cemetery. Arrangements were with Lindley-Robertson-Holt Funeral Home of Navasota.

Pierce died Saturday, March 16, 2002, at the College Station Medical Center. She was born November 4, 1924 in Newark, OH, the daughter of John Joseph and Bernice Iona Wintermute Gainor.

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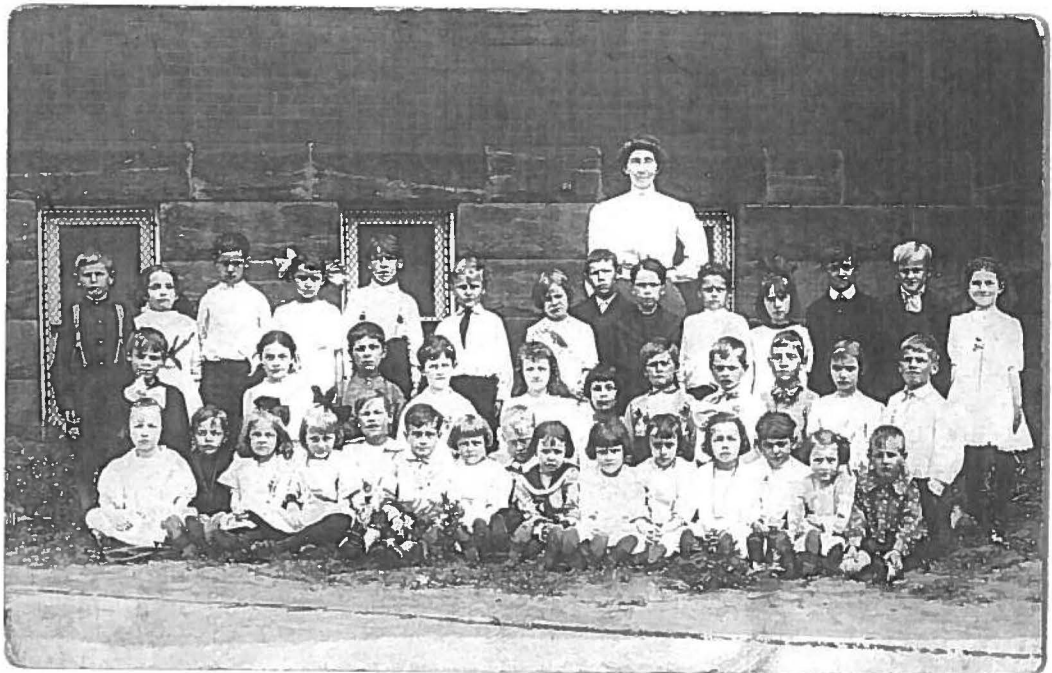

authored a column, "The Country Parson Ponders," in The Ohio Farmer magazine since 1945.

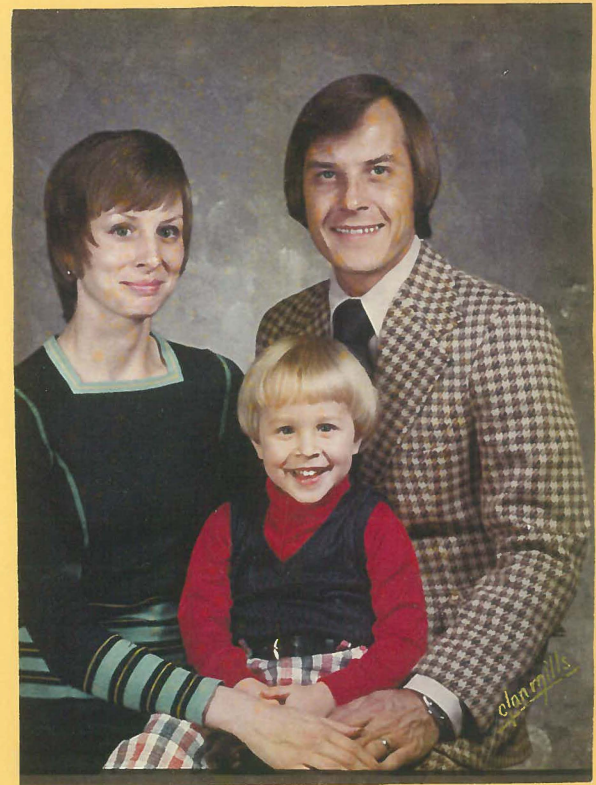
Also on the program will be two selections by the band.

Local Man Raising Mink Uses Bite-proof Gloves

Bite-proof gloves are essential in raising mink, according to William R. Patterson, West st., who has been in this business since the first of the year.

Mr. Patterson has developed great respect for the teeth of the nervous little animals whose black pelts make luxurious fur coats, because he has been bit numerous times. Once a mink sunk its teeth into his hand with such determination that he had to pry open the jaws.

His original three mink, purchased in Colorado at a cost of \$195, have increased to 14. Litters arrived in April. One included seven kittens and the other, six although four or five is the usual amount. Two died, making the net increase 11.

"The litters were larger than average," Mr. Patterson said, "and that was good luck. But there were only two females. That wasn't so good."

"I may sell some of the male pelts next November. They will be prime then. But I'm more interested now in increasing my stock."

Mink have one litter a year. A black pelt brings \$17 to \$18, he said.

"I hope to make out on this deal," Mr. Patterson said, "but there are many uncertainties. One of the worst hazards is disease. You have to be careful to see that mink get a balanced diet. When they are half-grown

they must be put in pens by themselves. Otherwise they will fight. At first they just play rough, but they keep getting rougher until one bites too hard. Once they get a taste of blood they tear viciously at each other."

Mr. Patterson feeds the babies twice a day and the older ones once. It takes three and a half pounds of food daily for his 14 animals.

Their diet includes 90 per cent ground meat and 10 per cent vegetables and cereals. Recently Mr. Patterson butchered a horse that netted 400 pounds of mink food. Most of it is stored in a deep-freezer at his home. They also like carp, but it must be ground. Their favorite vegetables are lettuce and tomatoes.

Just before meal times the little animals become more restless than usual and race around their pens like demons.

Mr. Patterson demonstrated why he has to handle them with heavy gloves. He picked up a black-furred kitten. It squealed unmercifully and bit furiously at the gloves.

Mr. Patterson has nine pens and will need more. They are about three feet above the ground. A wire fence surrounds the area as a secondary barrier.

There is another mink raiser in this vicinity. William Opphile, Post Boy, has about 70 at his farm.

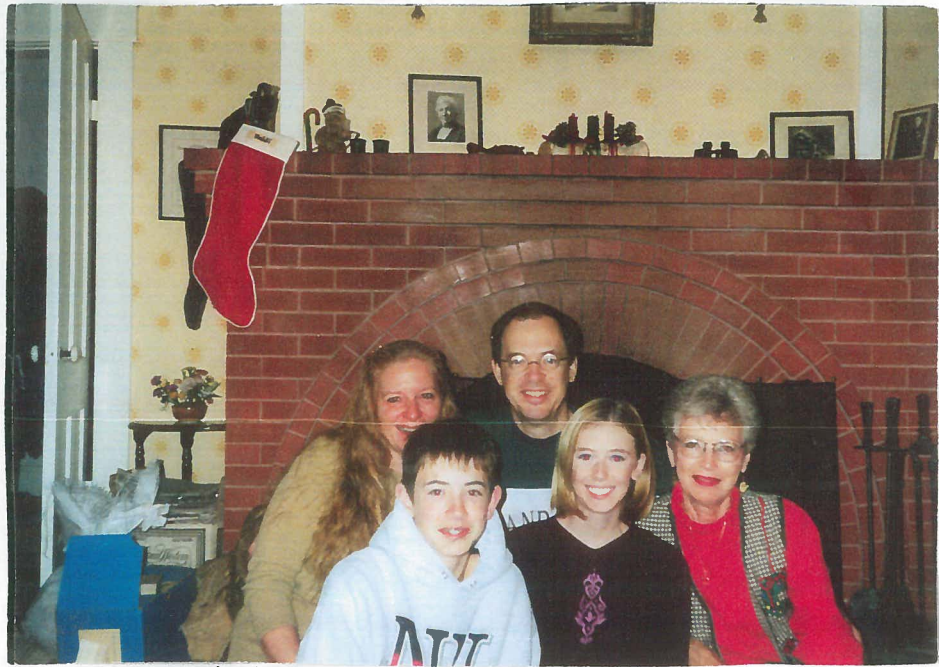

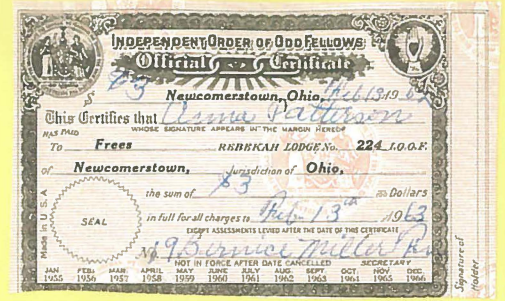
