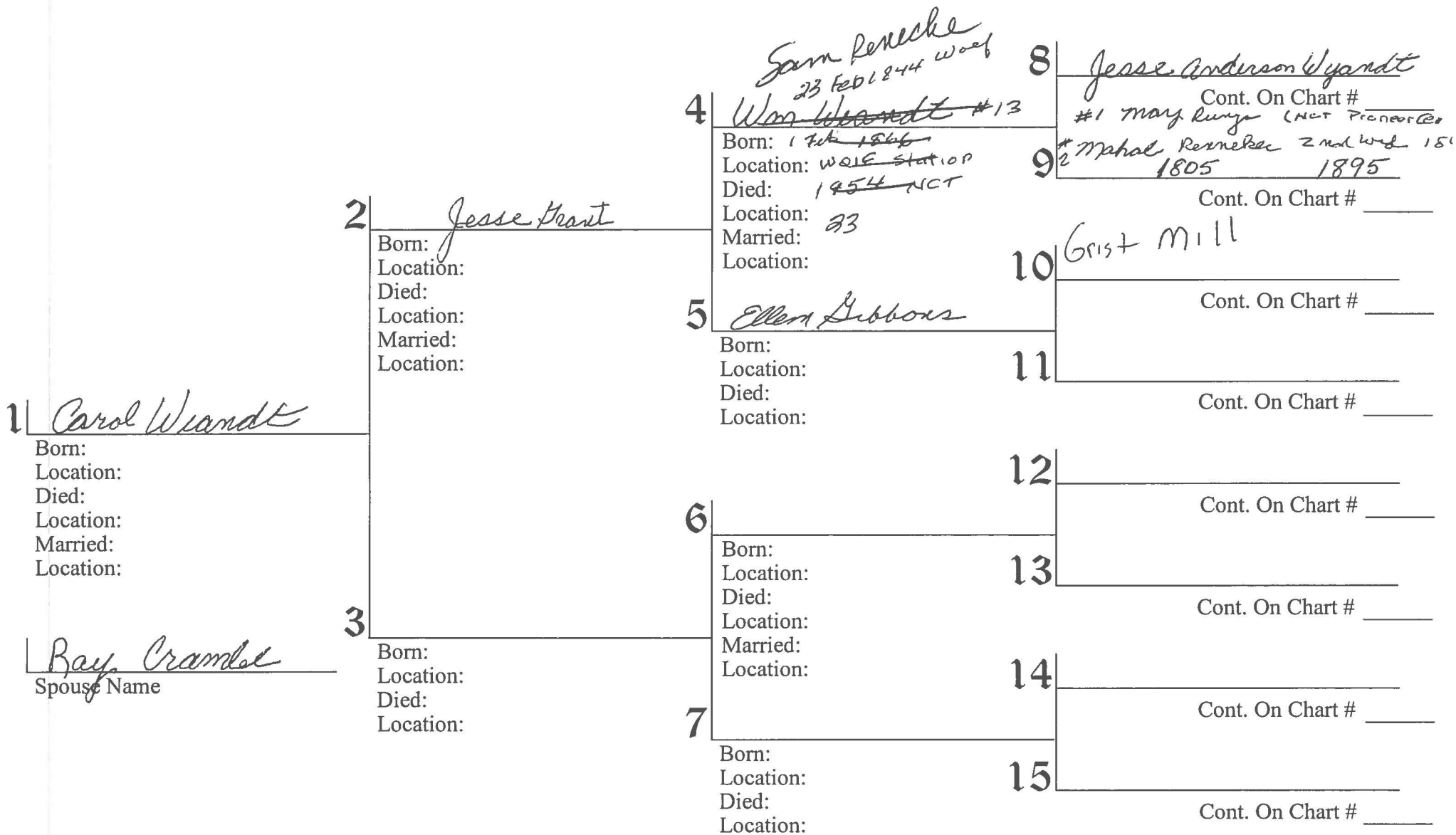

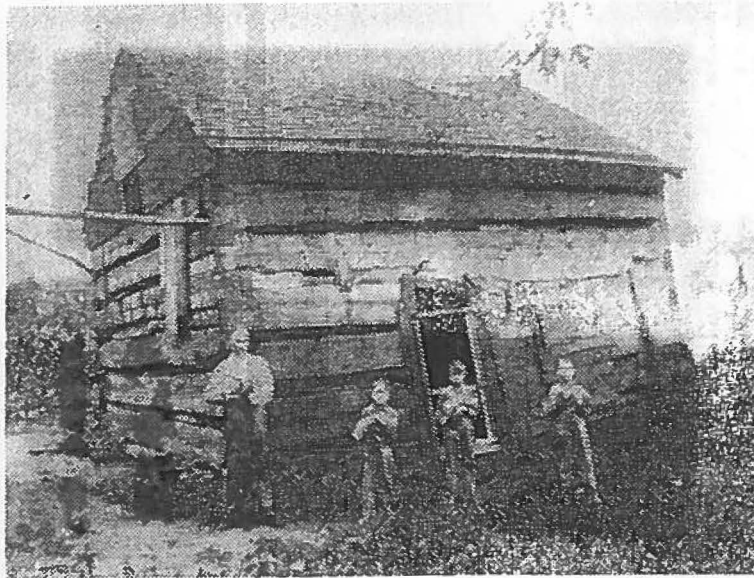

This pioneer cabin was one of the first houses in Newcomerstown being built about 1815. William Wiandt and three sons are each holding a rabbit.



Years later, on one of his raids into the Virginia Territory, Chief Eagle Feather captured another white woman for a second wife. What occurred between these two white women is not known but one morning Chief Eagle Feather was discovered dead with his own tomahawk buried in his skull and the "newcomer", as Mary Harris supposedly called her, was gone.

The newcomer was captured on the present site of our town and returned to the village of Chief Eagle Feather and put to death.

Christopher Gist, a surveyor for the Ohio Land Company had talked to Mary Harris in 1750 and gave no indication, as erroneously reported by several Ohio history writers, of having seen the newcomer executed.

David Zeisberger tells us that Newcomerstown was the village of Chief Natawatwes who later changed his name to King Newcomer.

King Newcomer had invited Zeisberger to preach to his tribe and on March 14,



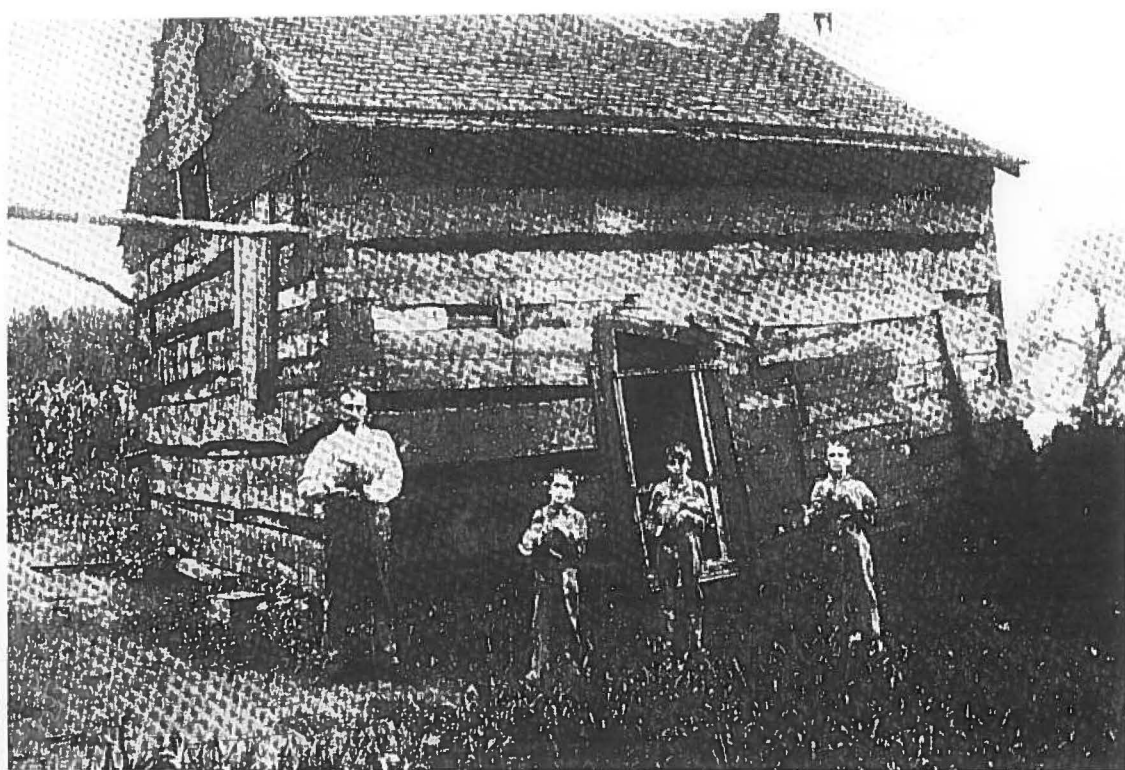

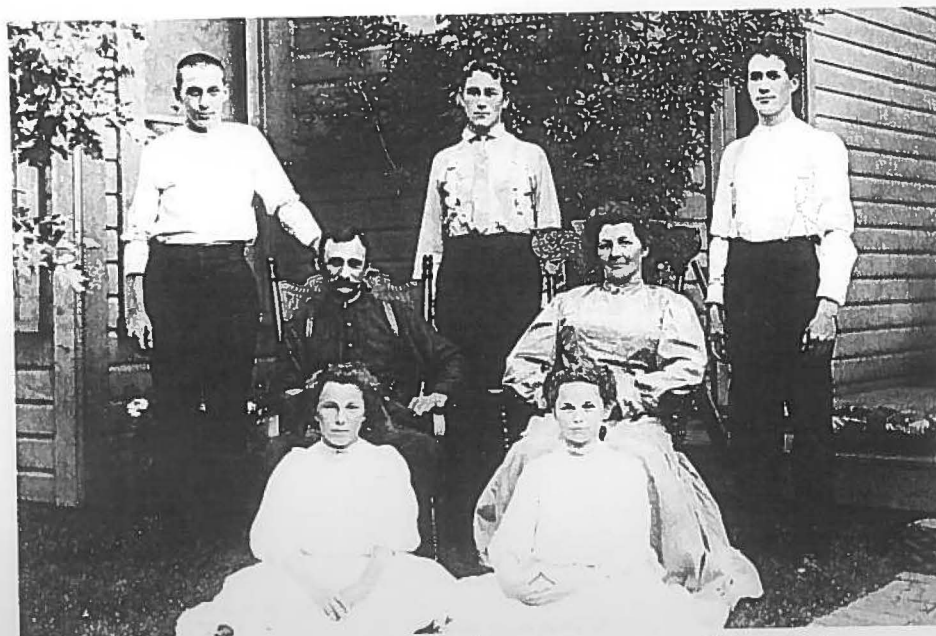

Notes for JOHANN WENDEL WIEGANDT:

Johann Wendel spelled his last name "Wiant", although his brother, Jost spelled it "Wiegandt". Other variations do exist.

Johann Wendel Wyant, 20 years old, arrived in Philadelphia on 17 August 1729, aboard the ship "Mortonhouse," James Coultas, Commander, last from Rotterdam. He signed the declaration on 19 August 1729.

Wendel settled in New Goshenhoppen, now Upper Hanover Twp. By 1731, he had married Margaret

Fisher, daughter of Jacob and Anna Sophia Fisher of New Goshenhoppen. It is possible that the Fisher and Wyant families knew each other in Freinsheim. The Fisher family arrived in Philadelphia on October 2, 1727 from there.

The Wyant family were members of the New Goshenhoppen Reformed Church, where Wendel is listed as a head of a household in 1731, as Wendel Wiandt. His family settled in Montgomery, Lehigh, and Bucks Cos. PA.

Wendel Wyand of Philadelphia County was naturalized in the term of Supreme Court held April 11, 12, & 13, 1743. He returned to his native homeland in 1767. The trip lasted 46 weeks. He arrived back in Philadelphia on October 9, 1768 aboard the ship, "Minerva", Thomas Amott, Master.

Wendel's son, Yost Wyant and a friend, Jacob Goho visited North Carolina in 1781. They were gone 12 weeks and 4 days.

via the "national trail" (which today is U.S. #40) across the Laurel Ridge, through Uniontown and Little Washington, then Wheeling, WVa. and into Ohio. He then went to Carroll County, OH where, at age 24, he was married to Mary Runyan, who was a native of Pennsylvania as well. The wedding was held on March 12, 1829 and performed by John Wagonhols, Minister of the Gospel.

Mary (Runyan) Wiandt was born around March of 1808 and was 21 years old when she and Jesse were married. From Carroll County the Wiandts moved to Tuscarawas County, OH and settled in Salem Township. A son was born to them in Salem Twp. on July 22, 1837 and they named him Reuben Runyan Wiandt.

Mary died on January 23, 1843 at the age of 34 years and 10 months leaving Jesse, then 38, with little Reuben at five and a half years of age. Mary was buried in The Old Pioneer Cemetary which is located in Newcomerstown on South Bridge Street where the Penn Central Railroad crosses. Its official designation is Tuscarawas County Cemetary, Oxford Twp. #163.

The population of Tuscarawas County in those days was almost wholly German or of German descent. They were a thrifty and frugal race and many became quite wealthy. The indians had then left the country and bears had dissappeared, but wolves and deer were yet abundant.

The winter of '42/43 was a sad time for the Wiandts who had lost both wife and mother. Reuben being so young and impressionable, would likely lose memory of Mary, who gave him birth, but to Jesse, the now middle-aged pioneer, her death was certainly a strike to his heart. He had recently constructed a log cabin for his family one mile south of Wolf. The winter snow and the cold winds made Jesse think of the coming spring when he would have to plant his crops alone or perhaps work for someone else to earn enough to provide for himself and little Reuben. Many a night was spent beside the oil lamp with head in hands and heavy eyelids, planning a new life for he and his son. Hence, being a thrifty German and probably with encouragement from Dr. Enoch Wolf, his friend and neighbor, Jesse went out in search of a new wife and almost immediately found one. Jesse must have been quite the handsome gentleman, because at age 38 he managed to meet, court, and marry a maiden of age 16!

Her name was Mahala Renneker and she was born on October 15, 1826. She was a daughter of Peter and Christianna (Harbaugh) Renneker who had settled in Stone Creek, OH, (which today is Phillipsburg) and had raised a rather large farm as well as a large family of 4 sons and 4 daughters. Sixteen was a prime age for marrying in those days, so Mahala was a good candidate when Jesse Wiandt rode into town! Mahala and Jesse were married on April 4, 1843 by E.C. Young, M.G. (Minister of the Gospel).

Jesse led his young bride from the big farm to the little old log cabin which occupied the spot on which the later home would be built. The country was still a wilderness then, and the journey from her parent's farm above Stone Creek to the cabin one mile south of Wolf was not an unpretentious one!

Springtime of '43 came in as a meadowlark for the new Wiandt family! Jesse had secured the position as proprietor of the local grist mill. Little Reuben would now have a new mother and Jesse would have someone to tend his home and, unbeknownst to her, raise a family of 16 children! Within a month of their newly established home, Jesse and Mahala Wiandt got busy starting a family of their own!

February 23, 1844, a son was born to the Wiandts. They would name him Samuel Renneker Wiandt, after Mahala's brother, Samuel Renneker. Reuben, then six and a half would have a playmate and Jesse would soon have two trainees for the mill. {Sam married Ellen Gibbens on April 15, 1869 by U. Jesse Knisely, Ph.D., M.G. and removed to Missouri.}

June 8, 1845, the first daughter was born. She was named Mary Wiandt. {Mary married a Mr. Creamer and removed to Iowa}.

December 2, 1846, came another son. He was named George Washington Wiandt. It was a common, comic, yet noble deed in those days to name one's offspring after presidents or other famous people. {George also located his family in Iowa}.

October 15, 1848, came the second daughter, Lavina. Jesse was now 43 and Mahala, just 22. {Lavina grew up and married a Mr. Mumma and removed to Illinois}.

October 26, 1850, came another girl, Sarah Jane. {Sarah Jane Wiandt was married to Benjamin Franklin Burdette (11/21/1848-8/1/1922) of Winchester, Guernsey Co., OH on Christmas day 1878 by U. Jesse Knisely, Ph.D., M.G. at the Lutheran St. Paul's Church in Newcomerstown, OH. To them were born 4 children; Alvin, Artha Mahala (Burdette) Fisher, William, and Elmer. Benjamin was a C & M watchman and bridgetender for many years, eventually losing his eyesight and suffering for 11 months before passing on}.

August 7, 1852, came the fourth son to Jesse and Mahala and he was given the name Thomas Jefferson Wiandt. {Thomas was married to Jane "Jenny" Hammel on January 9, 1875 by C.J. Hunter, M.G., Presbyterian, who travelled between New Philadelphia, Urichsville, and Dennison. Tom and Jenny would have 11 children; Etta W. (Wiandt) Hosfelt, James Franklin, Mare E. (Wiandt) Goode, Jesse Anderson, John Thomas, Bessie Belle (Wiandt) Thompson, Martha (Wiandt) Lehman, Charles, Mabel (Wiandt) Meyers, George, and Washington. Tom and Jenny farmed around Tuscarawas Co. while raising their family then removed to Highland Park, Detroit, MI, where he died 12/7/1933 and she died 12/21/1927}.

June 25, 1854, came the fourth daughter to the Wiandts. They named her Catherine. {She grew up and married a Mr. Elliott and removed to Iowa}.

The Jesse Wiandt family was now half-established in 1854:

April 14, 1856, came the birth of yet another girl. She would be named Christina Elizabeth after her grandmother, Christianna Renneker. {She married a Mr. Davis and remained in Ohio through her years}.

October 26, 1857, came the birth of Henry Clay Wiandt. Henry's birth signalled a generation change in Jesse's family for soon his eldest son would himself be a married man. {Henry married a girl, M. Stocker on September 3, 1876 by Frederick Regula, J. P., Jefferson Twp. and they removed to Colorado}.

August 19, 1858, came the marriage of Reuben Wiandt, then 21, to Artha M. Richie, daughter of Daniel and Louisa Richie of Tuscarawas County. {Reuben and Artha were members of the Newcomerstown Lutheran Church. Two children were born to them; Daniel Jesse (7/25/1859-1899) and John L. (9/2/1865-5/26/1956). Reuben was a Salem Twp. trustee and devoted most of his attention to agricultural pursuits and owned a well-improved farm of 130 acres. Reuben died in 1923 and Artha in 1932. They are buried with their sons and their wives at East State Street Cemetary, Newcomerstown.

December 26, 1859, came another son to Jesse and Mahala. He was named James Wiandt. He would be five months younger than his own nephew, Daniel Jesse, son of Reuben.

February 26, 1862, came another daughter. She was named Malinda Issabelle Wiandt.

The family was now pretty large and hard to feed, but still not yet in full bloom! Jesse was now age 57, Mahala age 36, Reuben - 25, his wife Artha - 22, their son Daniel Jesse - 2 1/2, Sam - 18, Mary - 17, George - 16, Lavina - 14, Sarah - 12, Tom - 10, Catherine - 8, Christina - 6, Henry - 5, and Jimmy - 3.

November 26, 1863, came one more son. He was named John Brough Wiandt. {John located in Urichsville, OH when he grew up}.

August 26, 1865, Mary Wiandt, the second born to Jesse and Mahala, was married to William A. Stonebrook by S.M. Hickman, M.G. {She would later marry Mr. Creamer and move to Iowa}.

September 2, 1865, another son was born to Reuben and Artha. They named him John L. Wiandt. {He would grow up to marry a girl named Ada}.

February 1, 1866, came another son to Jesse and Mahala. They named him William Wiandt. He would be the last son born to the couple and spent his lifetime in Ohio.

February 26, 1868, another daughter was born. She was named Ellen Wiandt, and would become the youngest child to live a long life. {Ellen later married a Mr. King and settled in Ohio}.

April 15, 1869, Samuel Renneker Wiandt married Ellen Gibbens at the St. Paul Lutheran Church in Newcomerstown by U. Jesse Knisely, Ph.D., M.G.

May 22, 1870, the last child was born to Mahala and Jesse. She was named Laura Wiandt. Jesse at that time was 65 years of age, Mahala was 44, Reuben - 33, his wife Artha - 30, their sons Daniel Jesse - 11 and John L. - 5, Samuel - 26, Mary - 25, George - 24, Lavina - 22, Sarah - 20, Thomas - 18, Catherine - 16, Christina - 14, Henry - 13, Jim - 11, Malinda - 8, Johnny - 7, Billy - 4, Ellen - 2, and Laura - infant. The way Jesse and Mahala reared this family, there were probably only 10 or 11 children at home at any given time and some either had not yet been born or had already been out on their own. What a job to raise 16 children in those trying times!

January 6, 1873, young Laura passed from this world just before the age of three.

April, 1874, the plat for Wolf's Station was laid out by Dr. Enoch G. Wolf, a long-time neighbor who was also a carpenter by trade. He donated the right-of-way, built the railway station, started the post office, worked in the mercantile business, built the Methodist Church, and laid out a cemetary all from his 200 acre tract of land.

January 9, 1875, Thomas Jefferson Wiandt and Jenny Hammel were married. December 25, 1878, Sarah Jane Wiandt and Benjamin Franklin Burdette were married.

August 20, 1895, Jesse Anderson passed away at the age of 90 years and 26 days. He was laid to rest at the East State Street Cemetary, Oxford Twp. #162. His tombstone d.d. reads ? - 9/1/1895 90y 26d.

August, 1904, Mahala (Renneker) Wiandt passed away at the home of her son, William, at the age of 77 years and 10 months. She was laid to rest beside her beloved Jesse. And so ends the mortal career of these honest, yet sturdy pioneers.

I received your letter a few days ago & will try & write you few lines. It is hard for me to tell you the sad news, Frank passed away on the 1 on this month & was laid to rest. He was sick for 4 months. It was something awful the way he suffered. I took care of him day and night for three months myself till he got so helpless I could not handle him. He got so he couldn't walk a step nor get up out of his chair. He could not lay down during all his sickness. Just sat in his chair day and night till he was just worn out. Notes for WILLIAM JOHN YOKES:

Will Yokes enlisted in the Navy at Cleveland, Ohio, on Jan 3, 1942 and ultimately advanced to the rank of Seaman 2nd class.

Attached to the armed guard detachment in "SS Steel Navigator," Yokes was killed in action on Oct 19, 1942 when his ship...a straggler from Convoy ON-137...was attacked by the German submarine U-610. For several days prior to the engagement, heavy seas and high winds had caused a dangerous shift in ballast in the merchantman. Yokes acted beyond the scope of his duty when he and his shipmates volunteered to go below and perform the physically exhausting task of shifting ballast to trim the ship. That they did for some 30 hours without rest. On October 19, 1942, lookouts spotted the periscope of U-610, and the armed guard unit swiftly manned their guns. Soon the gunfire registered several near-misses to the enemy's periscope, and he withdrew temporarily.

Later that day, U-610 returned and torpedoed the hapless merchantman, sinking her immediately. Among the dead, Yokes was commended posthumously by the Chief of Naval Personnel, who cited the seaman's "courageous and unflinching devotion to duty...fortitude, skill, and bravery" in conduct "in keeping with the highest traditions of the naval service."

U.S.S. YOKES (DE-668) Destroyer Escort was laid down on 22 August 1943 at Orange, Texas, by the Consolidated Steel Company; launched on 27 November 1943; sponsored by Mrs. Charlotte Yokes, the widow of Seaman Yokes; reclassified from DE-668 to a high speed transport, ADP-69, on 27 June 1944; and commissioned on 18 December 1944, Lt. Commander Paul E. Warfield, USNR, in command.

(ADP-69: dp. 1,650; Lgth. 306'0"; b. 37'0"; dr. 12'7"; (lim.); s. 23.6k.; cpl. 205; trp. 162; a. 1 5", 6 40mm., 6 20mm., 2 dct.; cl. Charles Lawrence)

Following her shakedown training out of Bermuda and post-shakedown availability at the Norfolk Navy Yard, "YOKES" shifted to the west coast, via the Panama Canal, and arrived at San Diego, California on 14 March 1945. After further training, YOKES departed San Diego on 19 March, bound for the Hawaiian Islands. She made port at Pearl

Harbor on the 26th and trained at Maui with underwater demolition teams (UDT's) for one week before she sailed for the western Pacific.

Arriving at Okinawa on 1 May 1945, YOKES operated in that vicinity through June, serving as an anti-submarine screening vessel, a rescue ship, and an escort ship. On 10 May, her gunners claimed a "Zeke."

The ship shifted to the Marianas in July, escorting LST Flotilla 36 from Okinawa to Saipan between 4 and 10 July and then briefly anchoring at Apra Harbor, Guam, before heading for the west coast of the United States. Proceeding via Pearl Harbor, where the ship took on board the 14 officers and 79 men of UDT-28 on 25 July, YOKES reached Oceanside, Calif., on 2 August. Transferring UDT-28 to LCT-395 upon her arrival, the high speed transport sailed for San Diego that same day.

Shifting to the Western Pipe and Steel Company yard at San Pedro on 5 August, YOKES underwent a 15-day yard availability before she conducted a brief stint of training off the coast of southern California. She departed San Diego on 5 September to return to the Far East, touching at Manila Bay, Subic Bay, Tacloban, Samar, Buckner Bay, Guam, Manus, and Shanghai on transport operations into the winter. Departing Manila Bay on 23 January 1946, YOKES steamed via Pearl Harbor for the west coast of the United States, making port at San Diego on 15 February and remaining there under repairs through the summer.

Decommissioned at San Diego on 19 August 1946, YOKES was berthed there, in reserve, until struck from the Navy list on 1 April 1964. Sold to the National Metal and Steel Corp. of Terminal Island, Calif., the hulk of the former high speed transport subsequently was scrapped.

YOKES received one battle star for her World War II service.

Driving was his passion. If you needed a ride anywhere or anytime, he would be there to pick you up on a dime. No distance too far. No time too long. He would wait in the car, never complaining, for as long as it would take you.

He took pride in his family, always bragging about his grandchildren, whom he loved so much. He actually bragged about everyone, except himself. Although one special pride which he held dear to himself was that in his entire lifetime, his lips never touched or tasted a drop of alcohol. Otherwise his pride was only evident when he told his stories of WWII.

He had been stationed at Clark Field Air Base in the Philippines as a supply sgt. in the Army Air Corps. We heard the stories over and over about the train ride across the U.S. and the hike up Mt. Rainier, then the journey across the ocean by ship. We heard about the seat that he sat in in the B-29 superfortress aircraft, nothing but a glass bubble at the nose of the plane.

Ed Rager loved his country. He loved his home. He loved his family. He loved little animals. He loved the little children of others, as well as his own.

And, yes, he did love The Lord. You see...he WAS a big man...in more ways than one. And now that his work in this life is done, we know he's in Heaven, talking to everyone. Alas...he was the man who talked to strangers...

The following information will document two families of several generations living in Ohio. They are the Samuel Renicker Wiandt Family and the Isaac Loster Hootman Family. Each family has been recorded separately with cross-references where appropriate. A third inter-marrying family, Clyde Samuel Padgett Family, is treated separately with cross-references. The cataloguer is related to all three families and has attempted to show the blood as well as legal relationships. Alas, complete information is not available in this record, but every attempt has been made to give accurate dates and spellings. When there is a doubt a notation to that effect has been made in the text.

The cataloguer, Paul Padgette, is repeating an explanation included in the Waite McKinley McDonald Family papers, submitted to you in June, 1989. I was born Paul William Padgett in 1925. After my mother's death (Elma Ople Hootman Padgett) in January, 1936, I was adopted by her sister, Gertrude May Hootman McDonald and Waite M. McDonald, in November, 1936. Between 1936 and 1963 my name was Paul William Padgett McDonald at which time I legally changed it to Paul Padgette for professional reasons. I first began signing the Paul Padgette name during the late 1950s as a by-line in editorial writing. It is the only name on all official records since 1963. In the following material several references to this confusing name change will be noted.

#### Samuel Renicker Wiandt Family

Jessie and Mahalia Wiandt lived in Ohio (Coshocton Co.). They were German speaking, and Mahalia, and, perhaps, Jessie, is buried at the Wagner (Waggoner) Cemetery, located in Oxford Township, Coshocton Co. O. They were parents to:

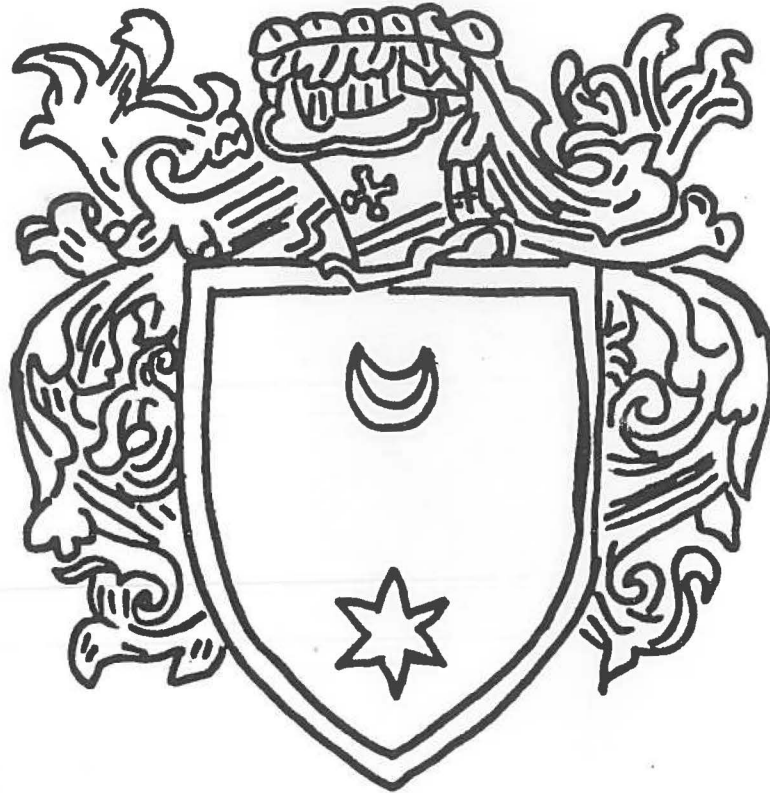

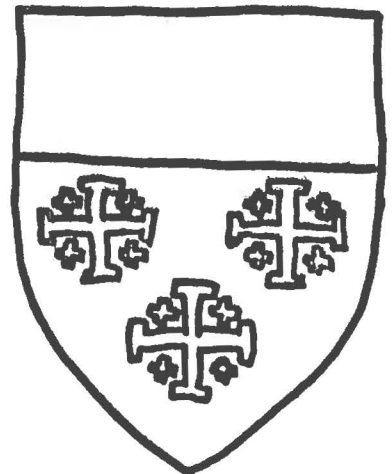

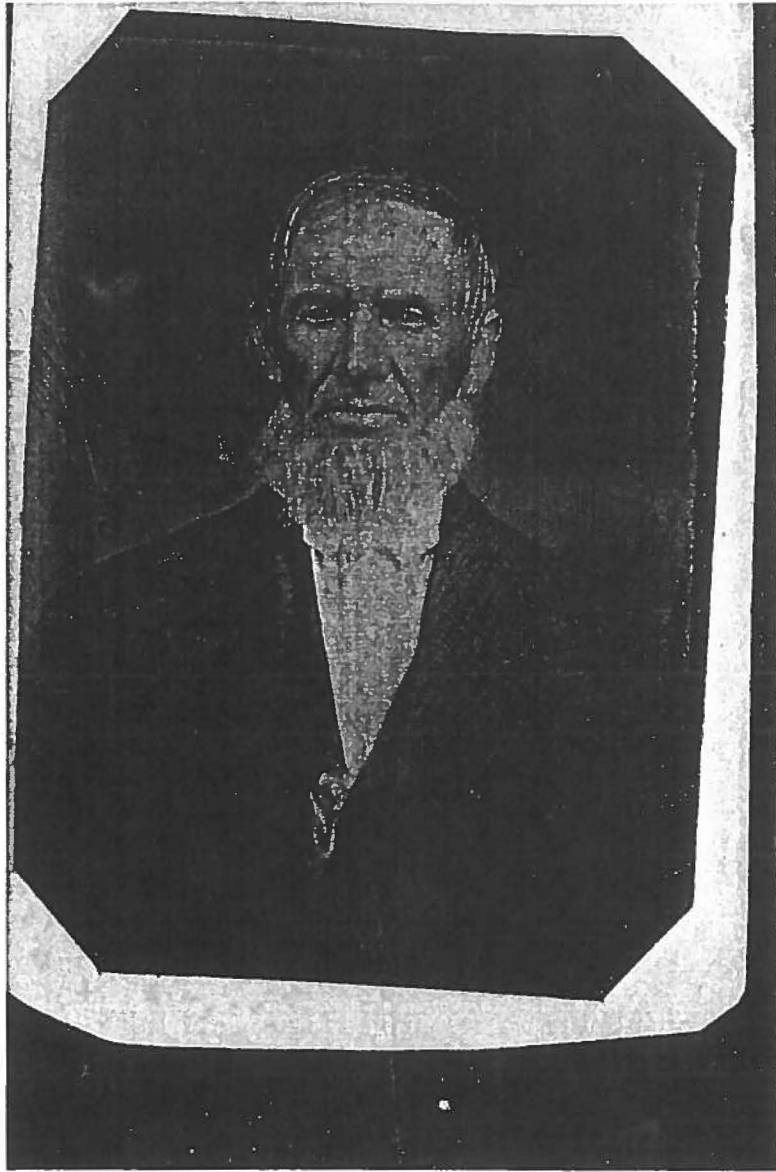

The Shield is blue with three crosses of Jerusalem top part of shield is silver or white The Crosses are gold.



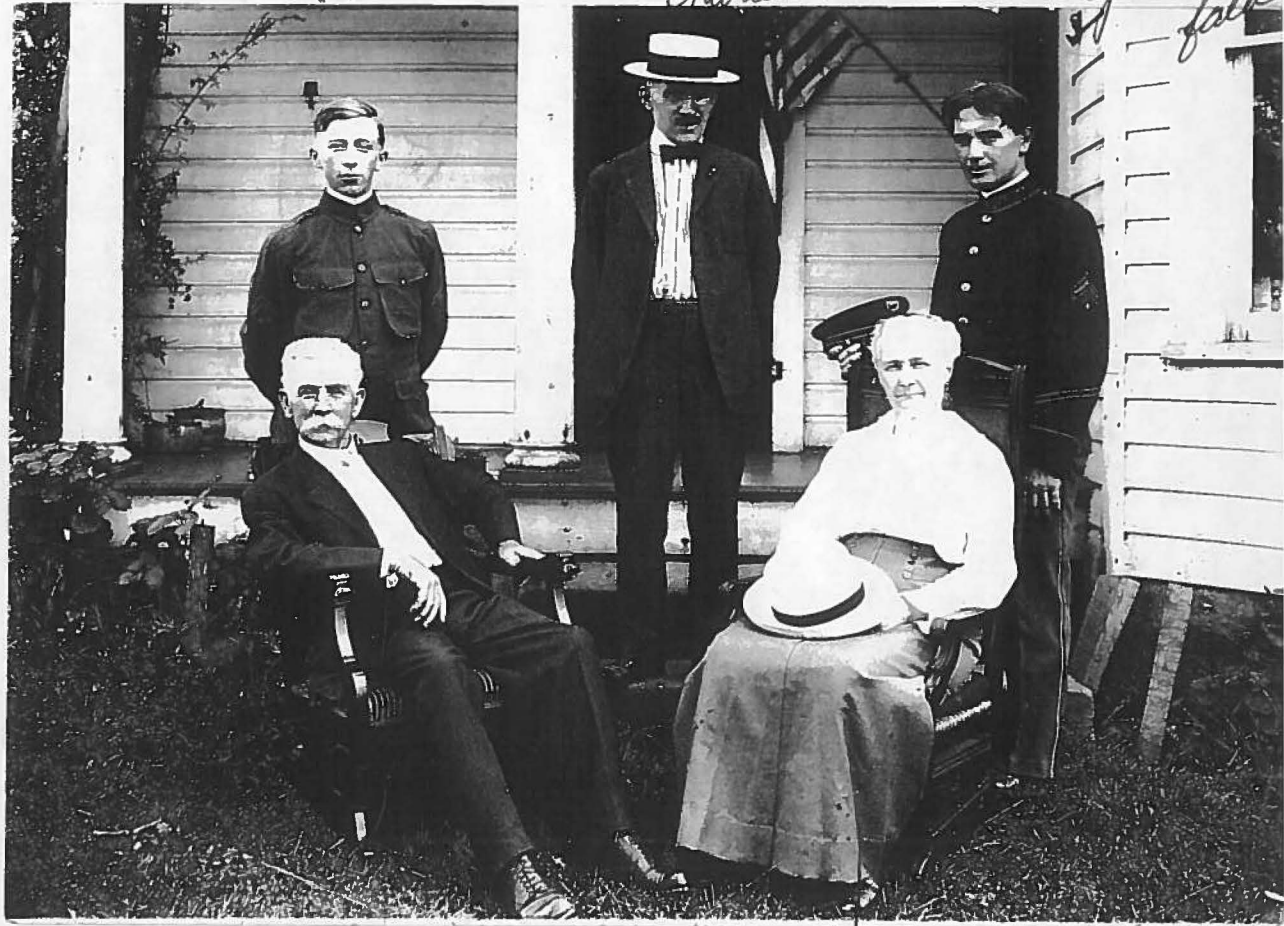

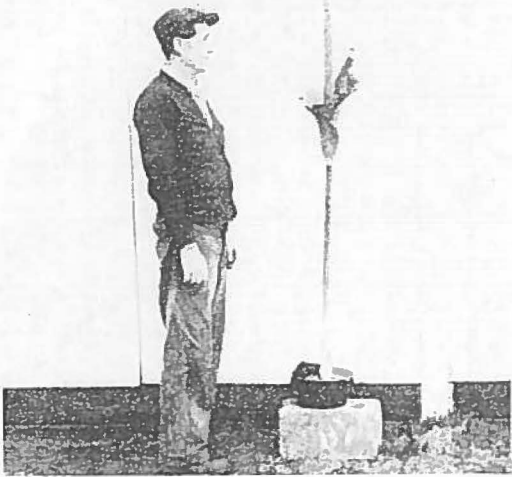
## Pennsylvania artist Andrew Wyeth dies at 91

Although some critics deride his art as drab and kitschy, Andrew Wyeth's melancholy paintings were praised by others as profound reflections of 20th Century alienation and existentialism.

Wyeth, who focused on the people and landscapes of Pennsylvania's Brandywine Valley and coastal Maine in works such as "Christina's World," died in his sleep at his Philadelphia-area home early Friday. He was 91.

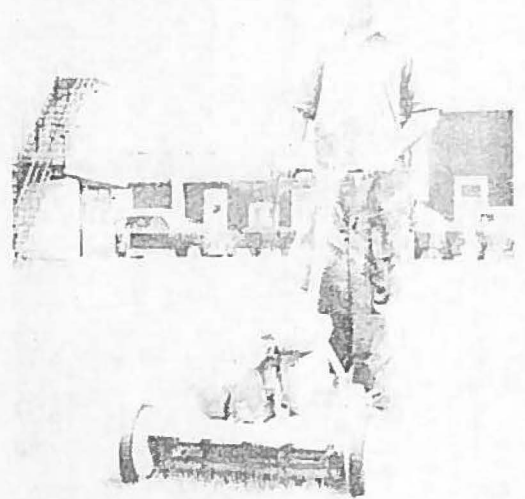
You've heard the story of "Jack and the Beanstalk" so now we'll tell you the modern version of "Jesse and the Sacred Lily."

It seems that Jesse Wiandt (Gasteam) is a man of hobbies and one of them is the growing of rare and unusual flowers so just recently he invited your reporter to his home to see his "Sacred Lily of India" which was then in bloom. On our arrival we were somewhat taken aback when we were told that because of its size it was necessary to remove it to the garage from the house.

Normally growing to a height of about only 48 inches this one had fairly shot-up to 74 inches, all in about two weeks' time. It averaged  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches growth in height every 24 hours. It grows without soil and the stalk is a speckled green. The bloom resembled a huge calla lily and is a deep maroon color. It alone is about 10 inches in diameter and has a stamen 32 inches long. The odor - well, we won't go into that. It's terrific!

Jesse told us that within about two weeks time it would all die away and the stalk would then sprout large green leaves for quite some time during the summer.

So that you might have some idea of its size and shape, Jesse moved it outside the garage for this picture.
