I need copies of some Chancery Court Records and don't know how to get them. They prove the heirs of George Wallick which the probate records did not. The index was found in Tuscarawas County Footprints Vol 11, #3, Aug 1983 pg31.

I also need to know name of wife of George Wallick Sr.(maybe first wife) He was a member of the old Union Church where St. John's Evangelic Lutheran was built. He was probably English Lutheran. Are there any records from this churches' early days? Also, according to tax records, he may have bought and sold land between 1820-1830. His wife may be on these records. I don't know if there were any newspapers this early in the area but there might be something there.

I am sending FGS with what information I have. I mainly need deeds searched, any church records or newspapers searched, and court records copied. Please send charges if you think you can help.

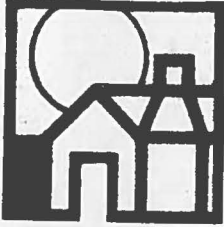
