

HOMECOMING

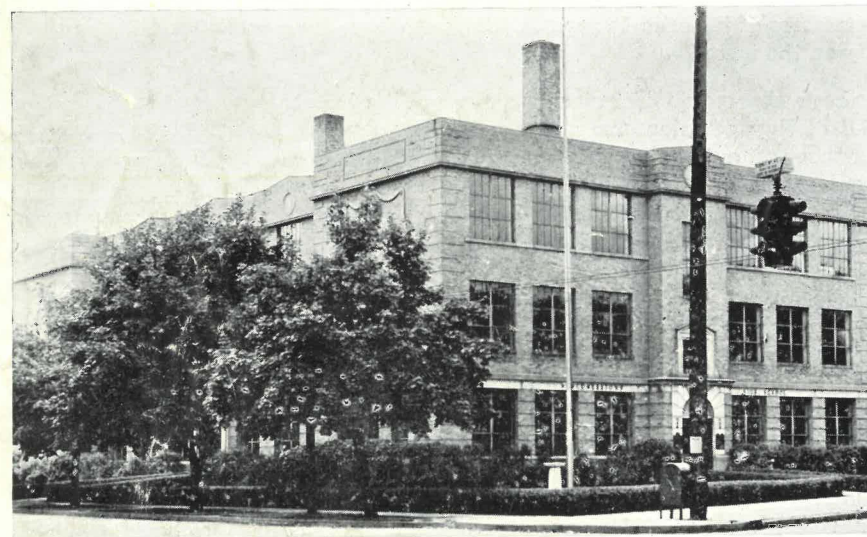

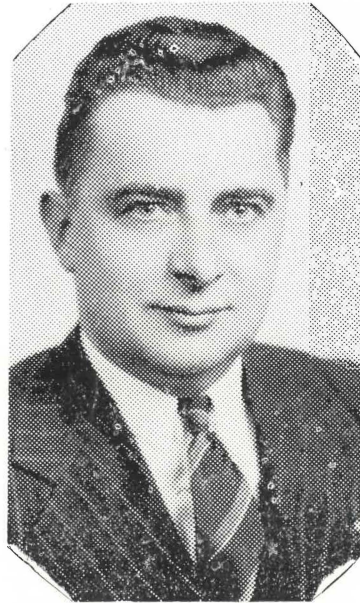
