

(page 221) Insert: Thomas Isaac was paid for making guns in 1776. (Source Walter W. Preston's History of Harford County, Maryland, page 319).

(page 240) Insert: John Wilmot was paid for service rendered (an unspecified service) on October 5, 1780. (Reference: Archives of Maryland, Vol. 43, page 315).

#### 6. Revolutionary Patriots of Anne Arundel County, 1775-1783:

(page 194) Replacement insert: Richard Talbott, Jr. (born 28 Dec. 1753 and died 22 Dec. 1821, Washington/Monroe Cos., Ohio) was a son of Richard Talbott, Sr. and Ruth Dorsey. An Ensign in Capt. Edward Norwood's Com pany in the Third Maryland Line by June, 1776 (Ref: H-38, H-39, N-534), he was commissioned Second Lieut. on December 10, 1776 in Col. Josias C. Hall's Regiment, Fourth Maryland Line, and promoted to First Lieutenant, April 15, 1777. He took the Oath of Allegiance before Honorable John Dow sey on March 12, 1778. He also fought at White Plains, Brandywine, and Ger mantown, resigning his commission March 17, 1778, and successfully applied for a pension in 1818 (Ref: Nat. Archives Revolutionary War Pension S-40552). He married (1) Achsah Wells (1760-1789) 20 Aug. 1778 in Baltimore and (2) Temperance Wells (1769-1830) 20 Jan. 1790 in Washington County. PA. Children by Achsah Wells: Absalom Talbott (1779-1816) married Elizabeth Mehollin or Mulholland; Elizabeth Talbott (born 1780) married Jesse Birch; Benjamin Talbott (1782-1845) married (1) "Nancy" Ann Fouts and (2) Sarah Gibbs; Charles Talbott (born 1784 and died by 1791); Nancy Talbott (born 1786) married John Lawhead; Temperance Talbott (born 1787) married Nathan Bradfield; and, Ruth Talbott (1789-1881) who married Alex McGee, Children by Temperance Wells: Charles Wells Talbott (1791-1874) married Eliza Smith McMunn; Providence Talbott (1792-1850), unmarried; Richard Talbott (1794-1848) married (1) Dorinda Wells, (2) Dorcas McIntyre and (3) Anne Agnew; Michal Talbott (1791-1871) married Benjamin James; Achsah Talbott (1798-1845) married Bemont Hubbard; John Dorsey Talbott (1800-1851) married Mary "Polly" Sheets; Ethelinda Talbott (1802-1873) married (1) Albert or Henry Jolly and (2) Bemont Hubbard; Ephraim Talbott (1804-1873), unmarried; Basil Dorsey Talbott (born 1806), unmarried; Joshua Owen Talbott (born 1809) married Adeline Williamson; and Wells Talbott (1811-1871) married (1) Betsy Cline (2) Barbara Ann Meek. Revolutionary Patriots of Baltimore Town and County, 1775-1783:

(page 12) New insert: Amos Ball, a Quaker, was reported at the Gunpower Monthly Meeting in Baltimore County on 25th day of 1st month, 1777, that he "hath joined the military preparations."

roage 23) New insert: Nathan Bond, a Quaker, was reported at the Gunpowar Monthly Meeting in Baltimore County on 28th day of 9th month, 1776, that he "hath some time been active in warlike preparations and is now ented in the Army."

(page 24) In the first entry for Thomas Bond on this page, delete "Another cource states Thomas Bond married Rebecca Stansbury on December 19, 1771, and that he was born in 1739 and died in 1787 in Harford County, MD." (Information from Louise Howard, of Baltimore, Maryland). She indicates Thomas Bond married Sarah Bond and their other children were: Mary Bond, married Aaron Helmken; Sarah Bond Bond, married 2nd James Gregory; and, Tobias Bond, died young. She also adds that Thomas Bond, of Barnet, was married in St. John's Parish.

(page 25) New insert: "Adam Boss (Boosz) was born in Lancaster, Pennsylvania [in 1757] and died on May 17, 1839, in Baltimore. He was with Washington at Trenton, New Jersey, and the capture of the Hessians, and was one of the guards that took the Hessians to Lancaster. Washington cut the Hessian banner into 13 pieces and gave one to a representative of each colony. Adam Boss received Maryland's piece which my mother, Catherine Weaver Goetze Browne, gave to the Maryland Historical Society about 1928. Adam Boss was with Washington at the surrender of Cornwallis. He was a member of the 1st Baltimore Light Infantry, Capt. Mackenheimer. He married Sarah Zeigler on January 1, 1782 in Baltimore. Sarah's father gave them as a wedding gift part of his farm that later was known as 13 N. Bond St. near Gough. After the Revolution they ran their home as an inn. They had 6 children, 3 of whom were: Frederick Boss, George Boss (born 1794, fifer in Columbian Artillery, Capt. Samuel Moal at the Battle of North Point, September 14, 1814); and Elizabeth Boss (married John George Martin Bondell.") (Information from J. Prentiss Browne, of Baltimore, Maryland). Adam Boss actually had more than six children. The others were Adam. Jr.. John, Henry, Sophia and Margaret. (See Chancery Court Papers No. 17898651, Baltimore City, 1813, and Adam Boss' will in 1839, Baltimore Wills Liber DMP #17).

(page 25) New insert: Adam Boss filed for a pension in 1832 while residing in Hamilton County, Ohio, stating he was born on March 9, 1762, in Bucks County, Pennsylvania. He was 13 years old when his father moved to Maryland. In the spring of 1781 his father's wagon was pressed into public service to go to the Indian Landing 4 miles below Annapolis to carry military stores from there to Montgomery Court House. Adam went with him and drove the wagon, serving about a month. Shortly afterwards, the militia was called up and he went into service again for about a month. Shortly after that he was drafted again and went with this company under Capt. Winchester to Virginia and was present at the surrender of Cornwallis. About 6 or 7 years after the war he moved to Virginia where he lived until 1822 when he moved to Kentucky for about 5 years and then moved to Cincinnati, Ohio. His wife was Harriot Randell (Ref: Revolutionary War Pension Application W10238, abstracted by Virgil L. White).

(page 52) New insert: John Colegate, Jr., a Quaker, was reported at the Gunpowder Monthly Meeting in Baltimore County on 30th day of 3rd month, 1776, that he "hath taken up arms and joined with the military."

(page 65) Robert Cummins: "The Maryland Journal on September 2, 1777, mentions the death of Captain Robert Cummins in Baltimore. I believe the Oath of Fidelity was signed by Captain Robert Cummins' father, who died on February 2, 1794. His will is recorded at the Maryland State Archives in Book 5, page 151 [naming his sons John, Charles, Robert, and Anthony]. Capt. Robert Cummins' grandson was born in 1782, also named Robert Cummins." (Information submitted by Robert T. Cummins, Jr., of Baltimore, Maryland).

(page 65) New insert: Edward Cunnard, a Quaker, reported at the Gunpowder Monthly Meeting in Baltimore County on 28th day of 9th month, 1776, that he "hath paid his fine for not mustering," and on 26th day of 10th month, 1782, that he "hath been guilty of carrying warlike weapons and neglecting attendance at religious meetings."

(page 70) New insert: Misael Deaver, a Quaker, admitted at the Gunpowder Monthly Meeting in Baltimore County on 24th day of 2nd month, 1781, that he "hath enlisted as a soldier in the present commotion attending this country, and had his marriage accomplished by a priest."

(page 75) Elisha Dorsey died in 1802, not November, 1806.

(page 81) New insert: John Ellicott, a Quaker, at the Gunpowder Monthly Meeting in Baltimore County on 31st day of the 12th month, 1780, was charged with "bearing of warlike weapons for the defense of himself and his property, and likewise he hath taken the test, and had been married by a priest."

(132) New insert: Aquila Hooker, son of Richard, reported at the impowder Monthly Meeting in Baltimore County on 28th day of the 6th onth, 1777, that he "hath joined in learning war."

(page 133) New insert: Gerard Hopkins, son of Richard, reported at the Cunpowder Monthly Meeting in Baltimore County on 22nd day of 2nd Bonth, 1777, he was "employed in diverse warlike preparations."
